

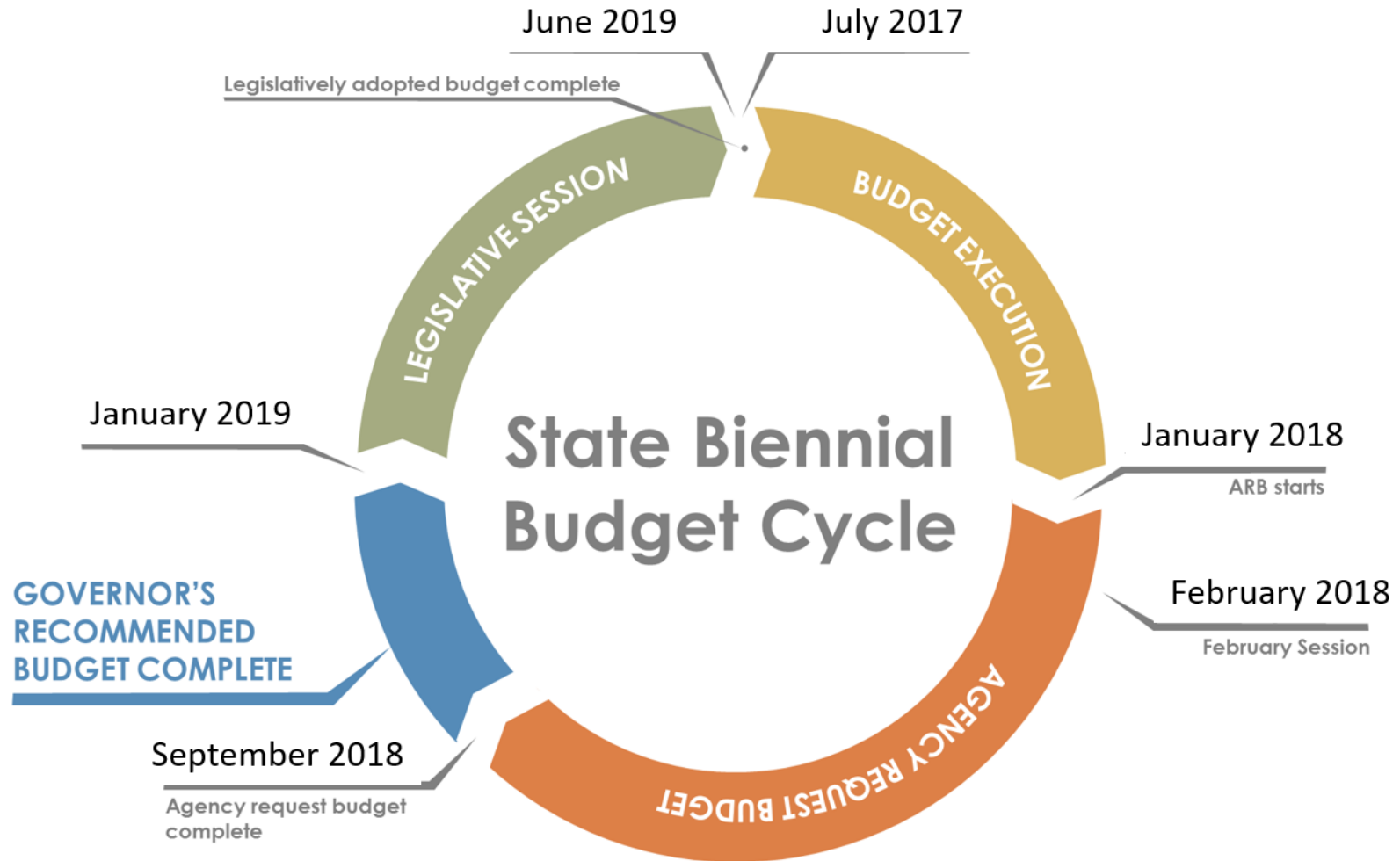

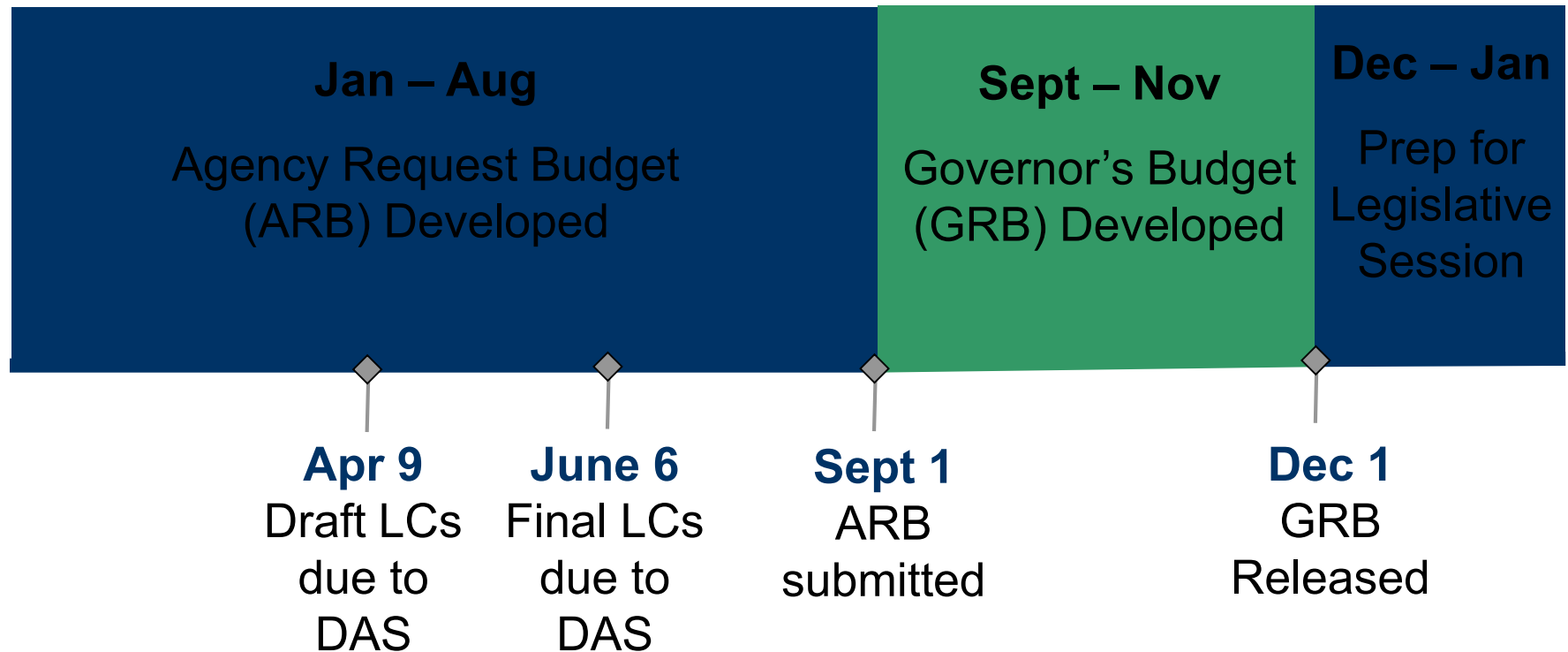

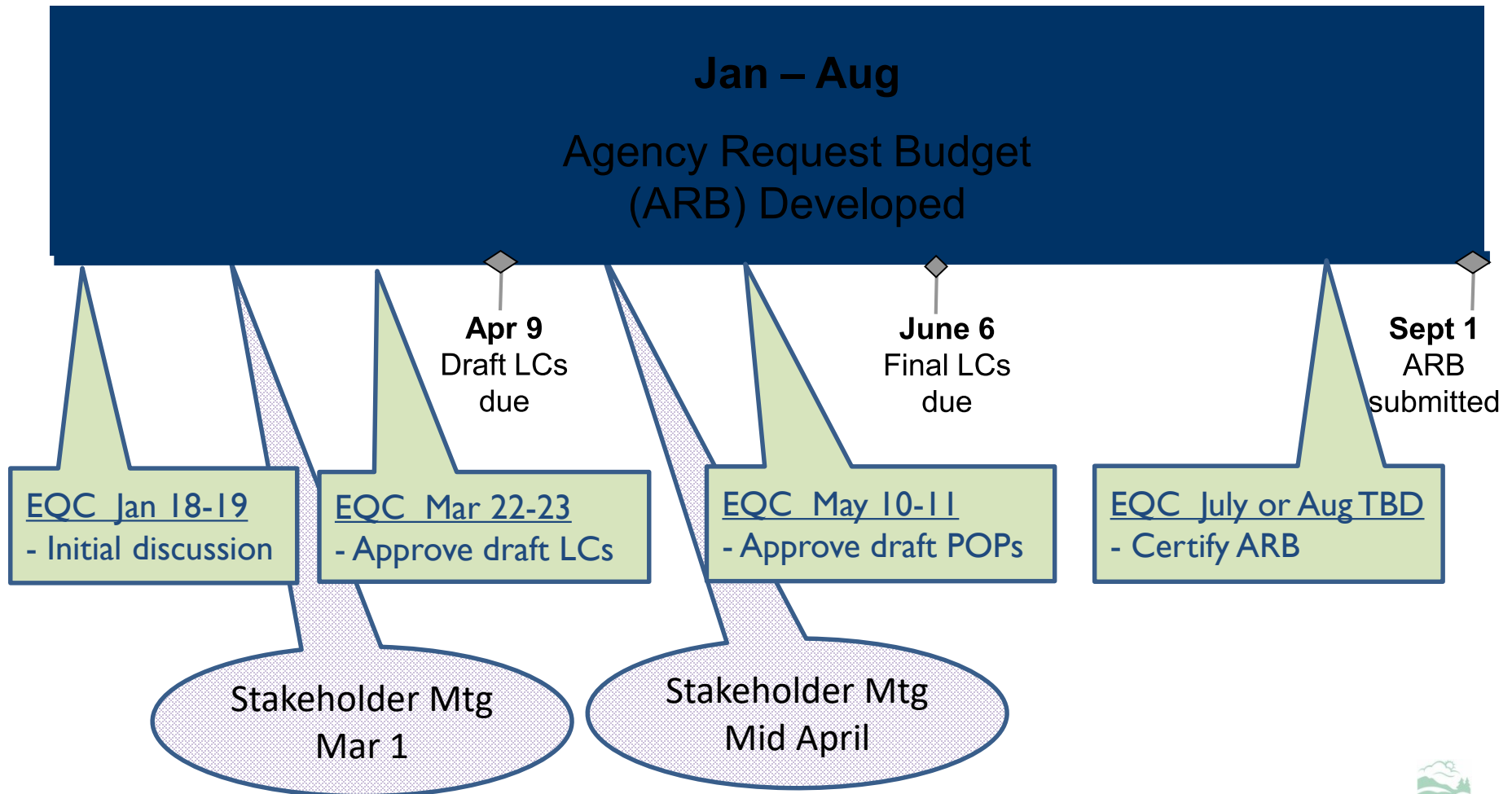
Oregon's Budget Process

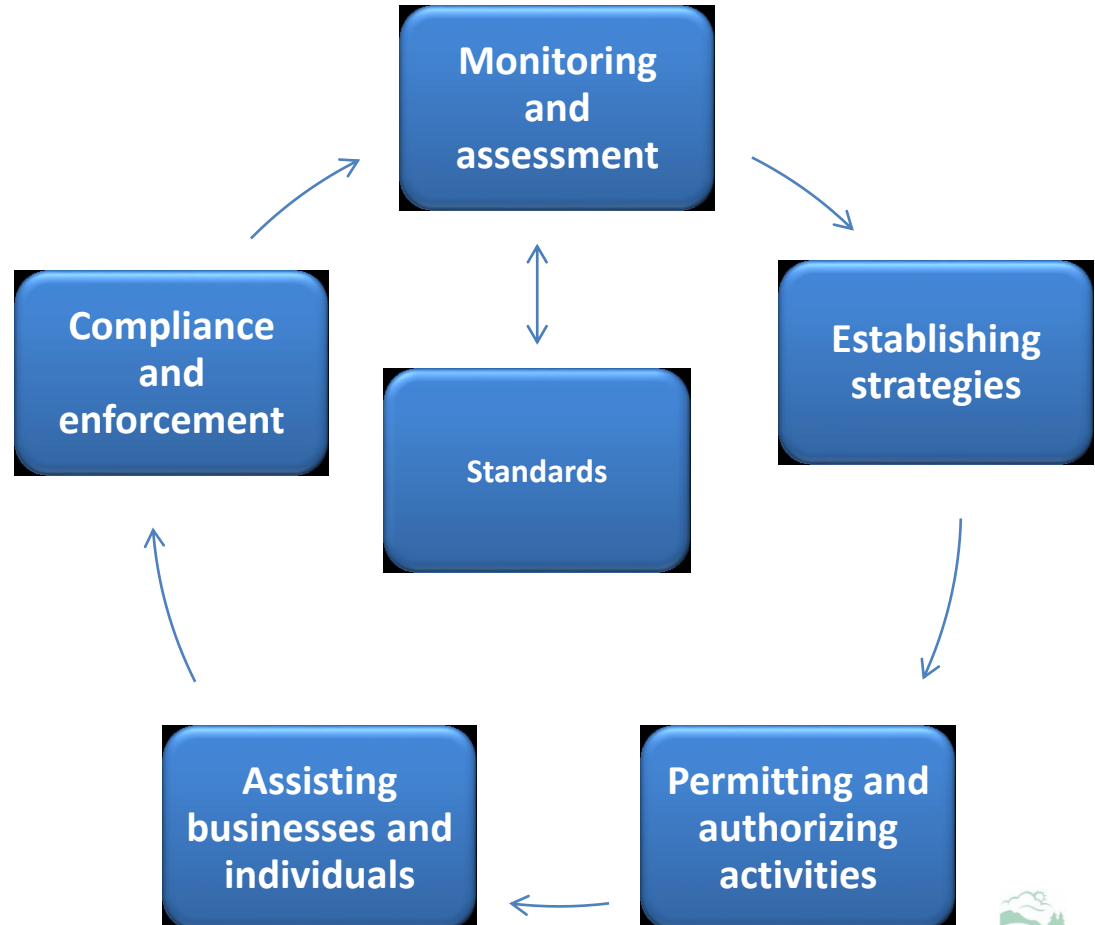

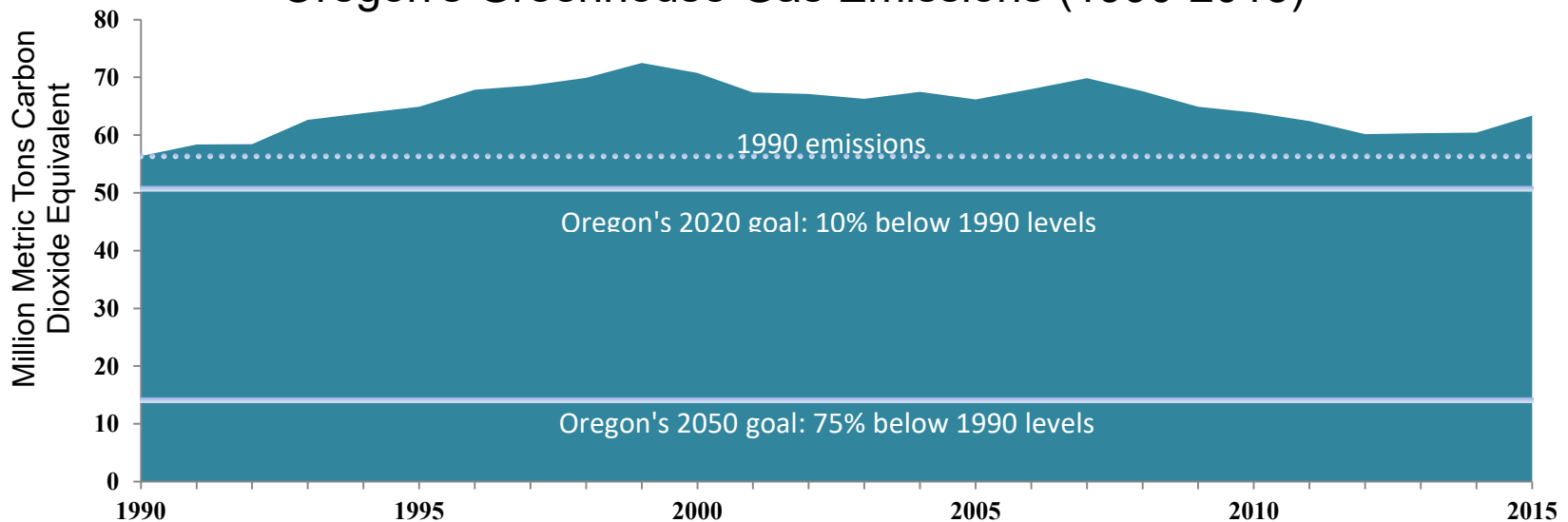
