






Wastewater Permitting Budget by Fund Type

Overview of Water Quality Permit Fees for Fiscal Year 2019

- 1. Fee increase of 7% for NPDES and WPCF fees
 - 3% provided under ORS468B.051
 - 4% increase approved in 2017
- 2. Fee increase for municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) annual fees
- 3. Fee increase implementation of 2017 Senate Bill 3, for general permits issued under ORS 468B.050 for motorized in-stream placer mining under permit 700-PM
- 4. Fee correction for WPCF permits, System Type E
- 5. Restoration of WPCF permit type F in OAR 340-045-0075, Table 70C, Domestic NPDES and WPCF Individual Permits that was inadvertently deleted from the table.



Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System: MS4










