This memorandum summarizes the removal activities and disposal documentation for the residual chemicals and hazardous substances inventoried by Akana on April 16, 2024 and documented in the April 29, 2024 Technical Memorandum (Akana 2024).

Stantec Consulting Services Inc. subcontracted with Peak Environmental for characterization, removal, and proper disposal or recycling of residual chemical waste and containers. The characterization and removal activities began on September 10, 2024 and were completed by October 24, 2024. Steel drums and large poly tanks were inspected and emptied of residual chemicals or waste. Residual drum contents were contained and characterized as nonhazardous waste and disposed of at the Chemical Waste Management of the Northwest (CWM) facility in Arlington, and Hillsboro Oregon. Residual liquid waste from poly tanks was characterized as hazardous waste and disposed at CWM facility in Arlington, Oregon. The emptied steel drums were flattened onsite and transported to Metro Metals for recycling. The emptied poly tanks were deconstructed onsite and transported to Oregon City Garbage Company for disposal. Waste oil was characterized and recycled at Oil Re-Refining Company in Portland, Oregon.

The residual chemicals and hazardous substances disposed of during this activity are summarized on the attached Table 1 with the receiving facility and manifest or receipts numbers. Akana conducted a site visit on November 6, 2024 and confirmed that the chemicals and containers listed on Table 1 have been removed from the site.

Disposal manifest, receipts and recycling documentation are included as attachments.

I have been unable to detect the non-wastewater organic constituents despite having used best faith efforts to analyze for such constituents. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting a false certification, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment."

B.4 DECHARACTERIZED WASTE REQUIRES TREATMENT FOR UNDERLYING HAZARDOUS CONSTITUENTS
