EQC special meeting Wednesday, April 6, 2016

Special meeting to take action on draft criteria and processes for hiring a permanent DEQ director

The Oregon Environmental Quality Commission will meet in Portland and via telephone conference call on Wednesday, April 6, 2016.

The meeting will convene at 2 p.m. and is expected to end by 4 p.m. The meeting is at the DEQ headquarters, 811 SW 6th Avenue, in room EQC-A on the 10th floor, in downtown Portland.

The purpose of the meeting is to review and take action on draft hiring standards, criteria and procedures for the recruitment of a permanent director for DEQ.
