#### **Clean Power Plan**

- Reduces national CO2 pollution 32% from existing power plants by 2030 from 2005 levels
- Accounts for emission reductions from lowering demand on coal power plants
- Gives states broad flexibility for achieving emission reductions

#### Fundamental plan design choices:


#### 1. Emission goal
