

Purpose of item The purpose of this agenda item is to seek approval from the Environmental Quality Commission for the chair to certify the Department of Environmental Quality's 2015-17 Agency Request Budget.


For state agencies headed by a board or commission, the budget submittals and associated budget books must be certified by official action of the governing body and signed by the Chairperson of the body.
