DEQ has modified the City of Gresham's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit no. 102523 to remove the final Ammonia limits from the compliance schedule and Scheduled A. The proposed major modification was noticed to the public as required by OAR 340-045-0055(2)(b). DEQ did not receive any comment during the public comment period.

Pursuant to OAR 340-045-055(4), this modification will become effective January 13, 2025, unless the city requests a hearing within 20 days. A request for a hearing must be made to the DEQ director in writing and state the grounds for the request. Any hearing will be conducted as a contested case hearing in accordance with ORS 183.413 through 183.470 and OAR 340-011. If a hearing is requested, the existing permit continues in effect until a final order is issued.
