PERMANENT STORM SEWER EASEMENT

The rights granted herein shall not be construed to interfere with or restrict use of the premises by Grantor(s), their heirs or assigns, with respect to the construction and maintenance of property improvements along and adjacent to the premises herein described, so long as the same are so constructed as to not impair or interfere with the use and maintenance of access of utilities herein above authorized.
- 3. The Grantee, hereby agrees to restore the permanent easement and the temporary construction easement to its original condition, as close as is practical to do so, upon completion of the construction.

EXHIBIT "A"

PERMANENT EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC STORM SEWER

Situated in Lots 1,2,and 3, Block 9 of HURLEY AND LARGE'S ADDITION to the City of Newberg, a duly recorded subdivision in the northwest and northeast quarters of Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, in the City of Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon.

A strip of land 15.00 feet in width lying 7.50 feet on each side of the following described centerline and its northwesterly and southeasterly projections:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 3, Block 9, Hurley and Larges Addition to the City of Newberg; thence S. 89° 58' E., along the south line of said Lot 3, 4.65, feet more or less, to the northwesterly right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad (per survey by Richard Mursell, CSP-7250, dated 6/15/79); thence N.43° 46'E. along said railroad right-of-way, 15.44 feet to the centerline of the proposed easement and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence N.83°07'13"W.,116.11 feet, more or less, to the east right-of-way line of Harrison Street at a point 25.00 feet north of the southwest corner said Lot 1 Block 9.

Also together with the easternmost 10 feet of said Lot 2 as platted, lying south of the above described centerline

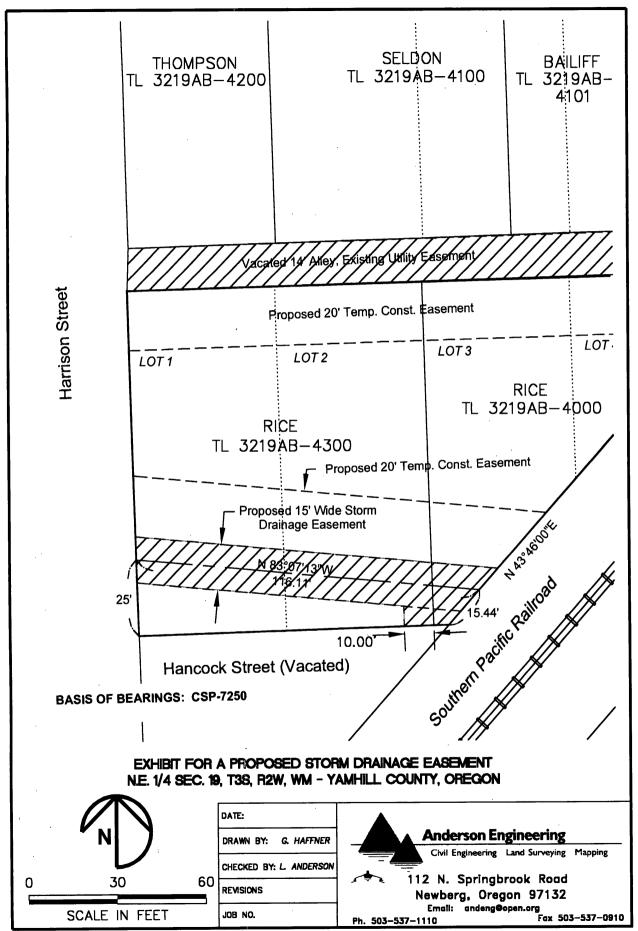

<u>Temporary Easement No. 2.</u> The north 20 feet of said Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Block 9 of HURLEY AND LARGE'S ADDITION to the City of Newberg as platted.
