Purpose of iter	<b>m</b> Director Pedersen will discuss upcoming organizational structure changes for DEQ.
Background	DEQ began developing an outcome-based management system in December 2010. For the past three years, before the governor and the legislature mandated state government to do so, DEQ embraced outcome-based management as its new business model. The agency is now working to reach its full implementation by transitioning to a new organizational structure that supports its outcome-based management system. Director Pedersen will describe the new organizational structure and
	the ways it reinforces the outcome-focused work of the agency.
Next steps	The new organizational structure goes into effect Feb. 1, 2014, as the first phase of implementation. Staff will continue their work in the new structure and the agency will evaluate any further changes needed as it works toward a shared vision of DEQ's future.
