Purpose of item

Each December, the Environmental Quality Commission has an opportunity to tell DEQ how commissioners want to engage in upcoming rulemaking proceedings before amending, adopting or

repealing the rule.

Background

DEQ uses Oregon Administrative Rules under EQC jurisdiction to implement Oregon laws. When Oregon Administrative Rules no longer meet evolving needs, DEQ proposes changes. EQC is the policy and rulemaking board that considers DEQ proposed rules before making a final decision.

Commission members have expressed the desire for DEO to provide a way for commissioners to plan how they individually and as a commission can keep updated on DEQ rule developments. Each year DEO presents its anticipated rulemaking schedule and provides the opportunity for commissioners to request information in many forms, from briefings to director's dialogue items to informational items, and give commissioners the opportunity to be involved in advisory committees, public hearings or request a hearing before the commission.

Attachment A lists and describes potential rulemakings on the 2013 DEO Rulemaking Plan. Attachment B is a worksheet for commissioners to designate their involvement with the rulemakings.

EOC involvement DEO recommends EOC members complete attachment B during the staff presentation for each potential rulemaking, and give completed worksheets to the EQC assistant at the close of this agenda item.
