The Newberg City Council met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Monday April 7th, 2025, and the following transpired:

- 1. A Proclamation was made regarding Child Abuse Prevention Month. Deb Bridges, a representative from Juliette's House accepted the proclamation.
- 2. Council Authorized the Renewal of Roger's Landing Lease.
- 3. Council passed Resolution 2025-3968 to sunset Fund 14
- 4. Council approved the Semi-permanent Street Closure at the junction of E. Illinois and Main Street.
- 5. The NURA -CAC River Street plan was discussed; council expressed support of the NURA-CAC plan and gave informal approval to have staff begin to working towards this project goal.
