You recently submitted a request for a time extension of a tentative plan for a Forest Dwelling. The Director originally approved the decision on March 20, 2019. Per the decision, the approval expires on March 20, 2023 (4 years from the date of approval).

ORDINANCE REVIEW

Section 19.65.070.G and 19.41.030.B of the *Josephine County Code (JCC)* allows for a one-time 2 year extension of forest dwelling approvals.

The following is required to authorize a time extension under Section 19.41.030;

1. The request is made by filing a request for an extension on forms provided by the Planning Office, together with a pre-application fee; and

Finding: Staff finds that you have submitted the time extension application and fee.

2. The request is made before the original permit expires, or, if the request is made after the original permit expires, "the extension(s) shall include the time between expiration and extension so total permit life does not exceed 6 years; and

<u>Finding</u>: Staff finds that the tentative Forest Dwelling application has expired but the total permit life of 6 years has not elapsed as of time of application (exp. 03/20/2023).

3. No changes in applicable criteria-based state laws or rules or county land development regulations have occurred since the date of original approval. The Director may apply conditions to the extension as needed to implement changes

in standards of approval only, using the Ministerial Review Procedures as set forth in Chapter 19.22.

<u>Finding</u>: Staff finds there have been no changes in criteria-based state laws or rules applicable to this project.

4. In the event changes in applicable criteria-based laws, rules, or regulations occur, a new application and application fee shall be required. The application shall be processed using quasi-judicial review procedures per Section 19.22.040.

<u>Finding</u>: As mentioned above, staff finds no changes have occurred; a new application is not required.

DECISION

The Community Development Director finds that your request meets the requirements listed above; therefore, your time extension request is hereby granted. Your new expiration date is <u>March 20, 2025</u>, which is six years from the original approval. There are no more time extensions available. *NOTE: The applicant is subject to all conditions of approval listed in the CDD decision*.

NOTES

- 1. Prior to March 20, 2025, you must obtain an approved development permit for the dwelling and/or must show substantial development.
- 2. The applicant is subject to all conditions of approval listed in the original decision (see attached).
- 3. There are no additional extensions available for this application.

16 Noticing Information: Pre-decision notice in conformance with the requirements of ORS 197,763 and Chapter 19.32 of the Josephine County Code (JCC) was mailed on February 12, 2019. The comment period ended at 5 pm on February 28, 2019. No comments were received prior to deadline.

The notice list is attached as Exhibit B.

1.7 Decision: APPROVAL with conditions. Based upon the Community Development Director's (hereafter "Director") review of the application and the evidence regarding the criteria as set forth in Sections 2 and 4 below, the request is hereby approved, subject to the

specific conditions as set forth in Section 5 of this document.

SECTION 2. EVIDENCE

The evidence received both in favor and in opposition of the request is contained in the Director's 2.1 file, along with all other documentation and evidence received and reviewed as part of this action. Other documentation may include aerial photographs, zoning maps, soil books, water studies, resource maps and inventories, facility plans, reports or comments from other agencies, and other like materials. These materials, in addition to the Director's file, are made a part of these findings by reference.

SECTION 3. CAC NOTIFICATION AND RESPONSE

The property involved in this request is not located within the boundaries of a Citizens Advisory 3.1 Committee (CAC).

SECTION 4. APPLICABLE REVIEW STANDARDS AND CRITERIA AND FINDINGS OF FACT

4.1 Section 19.65.060 – General Criteria for New Dwellings

a. The proposed use will not force a significant change in, or significantly increase in the cost of accepted farming or forest practices on agricultural or forest lands;

Finding: The dwelling will not force a significant change in or increase cost of farm or forest practices because (1) there are no commercial farm activities occurring on adjacent lands; (2) sufficient distance and terrain features between the home site and adjacent properties exist that will minimize any conflict with forest management activities; and (3) no comments were received from either of the two abutting properties which are receiving special forestland assessment by the Josephine County Assessor's office.

b. The proposed use will not significantly increase fire hazard or significantly increase fire suppression costs or significantly increase risks to fire suppression personnel;

Finding: The dwelling will not significantly increase fire hazard, fire suppression costs or risks to fire suppression personnel because (1) the home site development will comply with Chapter 19.76 fire safety standards, and (2) the home will be protected under a private fire protection service contract.

4.2 Section 19.65.070.B - Standards and Criteria for New Dwellings (Large Tract Test)

a. The parcel complies with all applicable provisions of law and is sited on a tract that does not include a dwelling.

Finding: The parcel is a separate, legal lot created in its present size and shape by Partition Plat 2009-30. There is no dwelling on the parcel.

b. The tract consists of at least 160 contiguous acres, or 200 noncontiguous acres in one ownership in the same county or contiguous counties.

Finding: The parcel consists of 323.10 contiguous acres.

c. A deed restriction has been executed and recorded that complies with the requirements of Section 19.65.070.F that encumbers all other lots or parcels that comprise the tract used to meet the acreage test.

Finding: This requirement does not apply as only one lot is involved in the application.

4.3 Section 19.65.080 – Siting Standards

a. The placement of the dwelling shall be located on the least productive, buildable portion of the parcel taking into consideration terrain, adverse soil and land conditions, access, vegetation, location and the size of the parcel.

Finding: The home site will be located in an area which has been cleared, leveled and widened for placement of the dwelling. The cleared home site appears to consist of slope less than 15 percent. There are no granitic soils on the property.

b. The site map meets drawing requirements.

<u>Finding</u>: The site map (Exhibit A) included in the application meets the drawing requirements of this Section.

c. The dwelling is placed so that it will have the least impact on nearby or adjoining forest or farm lands, and will ensure these impacts are minimized.

Finding: As indicated under item 4.1.a above, the home site is placed in a location to minimize impacts to nearby forest or farm lands. The closest property line for a parcel zoned as forest or farm land is approximately 1,000 feet away from the proposed home site. There are trees on the perimeter of the property to provide screening and provide natural buffer to minimize impacts to nearby forest and farm lands.

d. The dwelling is placed so that the amount of forest land used for site access roads, service corridors and the dwelling and accessory structures are minimized.

<u>Finding</u>: The site access roads and service corridors are located, as is the home site, in a cleared area which will require minimal improvements.

e. Risks associated with wildfire have been minimized through compliance with the Wildfire Safety and Emergency Standards contained in Chapter 19.76.

<u>Finding</u>: The applicant has submitted a fire safety plan for the home site that meets the standards of Chapter 19.76. The applicant will obtain a valid contract with a fire protection service provider, which is required prior to the issuance of any permits.

f. Applicant shall provide proof of a long term road access use permit or agreement.

Finding: The applicant has provided, and BLM has verified, proof of a long-term access agreement.

g. Parcels over 10 acres require the owner to submit a stocking survey report to the assessor and the assessor verifies the minimum stocking requirements have been met by the time required by Department of Forestry rules.

<u>Finding</u>: The parcel is over 10 acres; the applicant shall comply with this requirement prior to issuance of any permits.

h. The landowner has signed and recorded a document that binds the landowner(s) and their successors in interest by prohibiting them from pursuing a claim for relief or cause of action alleging injury from farm or forest practices for which no claim or action is allowed under ORS 30.936 or 30.937.

Finding: The applicant will submit a copy of signed, notarized and recorded Waiver of Remonstrance Regarding Forest Uses as a condition of this approval prior to the issuance of any permits.

4.4 Section 69.220 – Density Limitations (Deer Winter Range)

shall be reasonably centered on the subject property. Existing authorized dwellings located on deer winter range lands within the circle shall be counted. The number of counted dwellings, in addition to the proposed dwelling, shall not exceed a density of 1 dwelling per 40 acres [ratio of 0.025] when considering only the amount of deer winter range land.

Finding: The property is located within the Deer Winter Range area. The applicant provided the results of a Deer Winter Range test. To verify, staff also performed a fixed study area test as follows: three homes (two existing and one proposed) are included in the Deer Winter Range (two square miles, or 1,280 acres). Dividing the number of homes (3) by the acreage (1,280) results in a calculation ratio of 0.002, well below the 0.025 ratio threshold

SECTION 5. CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

Based on the evidence and the findings of fact entered herein, the Director hereby APPROVES a forest dwelling on the above-described property, subject to performance of the following conditions:

- 5.1 The dwelling, driveway, and fire safety measures must be sited on the property as reflected on the attached plot plan map marked as Exhibit A. (Section 19.65.080, JCC)
- 5.2 A Development Permit (\$300) must be issued as the final authorization for this approval (Section 19.22.040.C.4, JCC).
- 5.3 Prior to the issuance of a Development Permit, the applicant must:
 - a. Submit a copy of the recorded Waiver of Remonstrance Regarding Forest Uses to the Planning Office. (Section 19.65.080.E. JCC)
 - b. Submit either a stamped and signed statement by a registered civil engineer that the home site presents no issues which would require an erosion control plan, and that the driveway meets Chapter 19.76 requirements -or- a full erosion control plan, to include both home site and driveway improvements, prepared by a registered civil engineer. (Sections 19.83.020.B and 19.83.030.B, JCC) Note: Applicant has provided a full erosion control plan as part of the application.
 - c. Submit proof of an on-site well or a recorded shared well agreement. (Section 19.76.110.A.3, JCC)
 - d. Submit proof of a valid fire protection service contract. (Section 19.76.060, JCC)

- e. Submit verification of stocking by the County Assessor's office. (Section 19.65.080.D, JCC)
- 5.4 Prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy from the Josephine County Building Safety Department, the owner shall demonstrate that the wildfire safety plan approved by this decision has been fully implemented on the property. Documents shall include:
 - a. a completed Wildsire and Emergency Safety Standards Checklist for Forest Zones (available on the Planning website under "Article 76 Forms")
 - b. a letter from your fire protection service provider approving the driveway
 - c. a letter from the engineer of record indicating that the erosion control plan has been installed and implemented on the property.

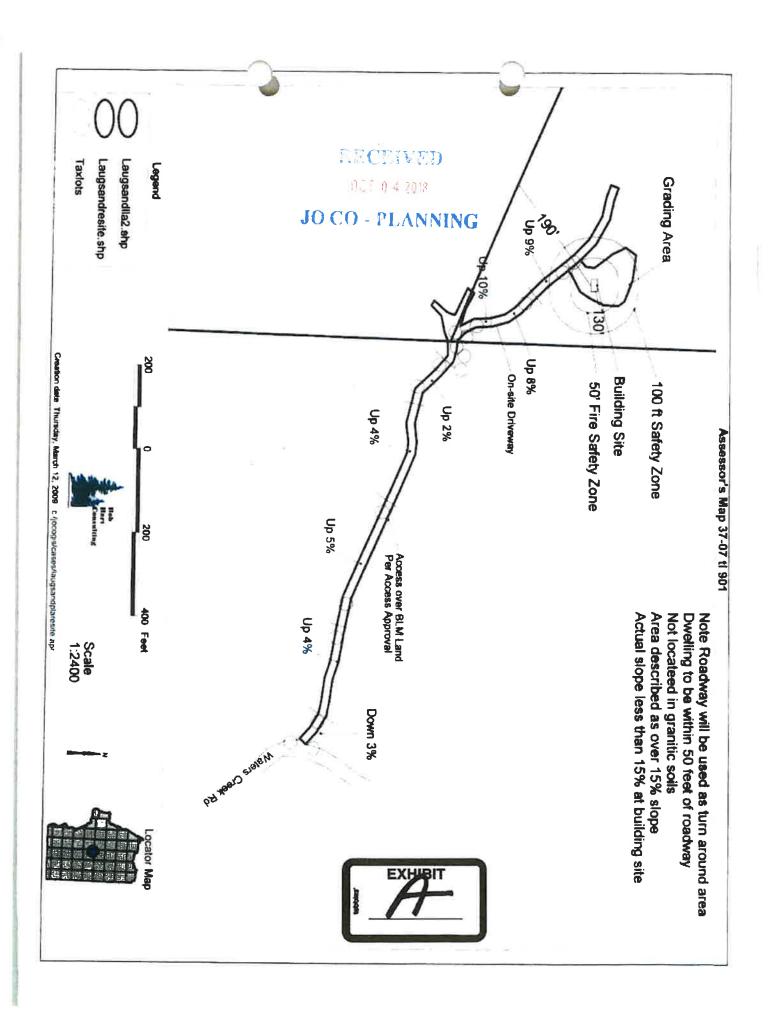

Important Note: According to Oregon law your dwelling approval is valid for a period of 4 years starting from the date of approval shown above. You are entitled to obtain a one-time 2-year extension of the dwelling approval as long as a written request for extension is received within 6 years of the initial approval date. While the permit is valid you must initiate substantial residential development (see definition below). The safest way to do this is by obtaining a development permit for the dwelling and complete construction before the original or extended time limit expires.

If you are not able to do this, then you must request a determination of substantial development. To do this, you will need to file a Determination of Development application, together with a review fee, and meet this standard:

SUBSTANTIAL DEVELOPMENT: Actions taken by the permit holder which encompass more than simple site preparation and grading. When actual site and/or physical improvements that constitute a considerable part of the whole project have been lawfully undertaken, such improvements must encompass more than simple site preparation or surveying, and must include physical site, structure and/or facility development:

- A. For individual home site approvals, substantial development shall mean:
 - 1. A development permit as required by the land use approval has been issued; and
 - 2. Evidence the following site improvements have been installed:
 - A septic system, or approved connection to a sewerage system provided for the property; or,
 - b. A system of delivering an approved source of water supply to the property (i.e., well report and registration approved by the Oregon Water Resources Department); verified for domestic use by a water quality report that confirms standards for potable water are met.

As a condition of approval for this use, the Josephine County Code (JCC) requires a written and recorded statement acknowledging the right of neighboring landowners to conduct forest operations on their properties as authorized by the Oregon Forest Practices Act. In addition, the JCC provides that conflict between authorized forest practices and residential uses will be resolved in favor of the forest practices. The JCC states:

The Forest Commercial [or Woodlot Resource] zone is intended to facilitate the right to conduct forest practices consistent with the Forest Practices Act and to encourage and promote the development and conservation of natural resources. Normal forest management, mining, or agricultural practices shall not be considered a nuisance condition in a Forest Commercial [or Woodlot Resource] zone, provided that such actions are consistent with the standards of the Oregon Forest Practices Act and do not extend beyond the boundaries of the Forest Commercial [or Woodlot Resource] zone. Nothing In this regulation is intended to interfere with normal forestry or agricultural practices that might result in conditions such as noise, dust or odor. Residents of this zone must recognize that the intent of the zone is to protect resource management activities and that in the event of a conflict between residential use and normal forestry or agricultural practices, this Code will be interpreted in favor of the resource management practice. [Chapter 19.65.010 and 19.65.110].

Also, ORS 215.293 requires landowners who obtain an approval for a single-family dwelling within a farm or forest zone to sign and record a document that prohibits the landowners and their successors from pursuing a claim for relief or cause of action alleging injury from farming or forest practices for which no action or claim is allowed under ORS 30.336 or 30.337 (actions for nuisance or trespass are prohibited unless it results in damage to commercial agricultural products or death or serious physical injury).

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SHARED WELL WATER AGREEMENT1 (Based on HUD Model, Updated by WSC)

This Agreement, made and entered into this **25rd** day of **February** by and between **2**, party of the first part, hereinafter referred to as the "supplying party", and **LaVern T Laugsand Trust & Norma Fran Laugsand Trust**, party of the second part, an approved United States of America, Rural Housing Services, mortgagor, and hereinafter referred to as the "supplied party":

WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, the supplying party is now the owner of property known as **1802 Waters Creek Rd** (Parcel 1)2, located in the County of **Josephine**, State of **Oregon**, which property is more fully described as follows, to wit:

and

WHEREAS, the supplied party is the owner of **1834 Waters Creek Rd** (Parcel 2)2, located in the County of **Josephine**, State of **Oregon**, which property is more fully described as follows, to wit:

and

WHEREAS, the undersigned parties deem it necessary to provide a well system to service the parcels described herein, and an Agreement has been reached relative to supplying water from the well and the cost of supplying said water; and

WHEREAS, there is a well located upon **1802 Waters Creek Rd** (Parcel 1)2, together with water distribution facilities, hereinafter referred to as "water distribution system", for the purpose of supplying water to all properties connected to the said water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention and purpose of the undersigned parties that the well and water distribution system shall be used and operated to provide an adequate supply of water for each of the properties connected thereto, for the domestic consumption of the occupants of said properties, and to assure the continuous and satisfactory operation and maintenance of the well and water distribution system for the benefit of the present and future owners, their heirs, successors and assigns of the properties connected thereto; and

WHEREAS, the said well is deemed by the parties hereto to be of adequate capacity to supply a single family dwelling on each of the parcels described herein with water from the well for all domestic uses of a single family residing therein; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America, Rural Housing Services, will not finance or guarantee mortgage loans covering the separate properties and improvements thereon unless proper assurance is given by the parties as demonstrated by execution of this Agreement, that the water distribution system will have a continuous and satisfactory operation in accordance with the terms of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the water from the well has undergone a water quality analysis from the State of **Oregon** Health authority, or in the absence of local health department, results reported by a certified water testing laboratory and has been determined to supply safe and potable water; and

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WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to enter this Agreement for the purpose of reducing to writing their respective rights and obligations pertaining to said well and water distribution system.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and covenants herein contained, it is agreed that the well and water distribution system situated on

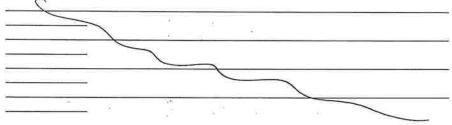
1802 Waters Creek Rd (Parcel 1) shall be used by the parties to this Agreement, as well as by all future owners and occupants of said parcels, upon the following terms and conditions:

- That until this Agreement is terminated, as hereinafter provided, the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns, for the exclusive benefit of the respective parcels of real estate, and for the exclusive use of the household residing thereon, are hereby granted the right in common with the other parties to this Agreement, to draw water from the well located on
- $\textbf{1802 Waters Creek Rd} \ \text{for ordinary domestic use excluding the right to draw water to fill swimming pools and other large withdrawals of any type .}$
- 2. That the owners or residents of the dwellings located on **1834 Waters Creek Rd** (Parcel 2)3, as of the date of this Agreement shall:
- Pay or cause to be paid to the supplying party, an annual or quarterly fee for this use of the well and water distribution system;
- b. Pay or cause to be paid promptly, a proportionate share of all expenses for the operation and maintenance of the well and water distribution system that may become necessary. Each respective share shall be determined by dividing the amount of each expense by two, it being understood that the supplying party and the supplied party shall pay an amount equal to one half5 of the total of such necessary repair or replacement. Shared expenses include the cost of electricity for pumping, repairs, and maintenance on said well and water distribution system.
- 3. That the cost of any removal or replacement of pre-existing site improvements on an individual parcel necessary for system operation, maintenance, replacement, improvements, inspection or testing, damaged as a result of repair of the well or water distribution system maintenance will be borne by the owner of the affected parcel, except that costs to remove and replace common boundary fencing or walls damaged as a result of repair shall be shared equally between or among parties so damaged.
- 4. That each of the parties hereby agrees that they will promptly repair, maintain and replace all water pipes or mains serving their respective dwellings.
- 5. That each of the parties hereby agrees to annual well water sampling and testing at a minimum by a certified water testing laboratory and well inspection every five years at minimum by a licensed well contractor as part of a regular maintenance plan.



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- 6. That the consent of all parties to pay a proportionate share of costs shall be obtained prior to embarking upon expenditures for system maintenance, replacement or improvement, except in emergency situations. An arbitrator shall be chosen by the parties; shall be consulted in the event the parties cannot agree regarding the said expenditures; and the arbitrator's decision shall be definitive.
- 7. That the supplied party shall pay to the supplying party his proportionate share for the cost of energy for the operation of the pumping equipment. This cost shall be determined by a separate meter upon each dwelling and for each parcel.
- 8. That it is the agreement of the parties hereto that the payment for energy cost shall be made not later than the 10th day of each succeeding month during the term of this Agreement. In the event that any such payment remains unpaid for a period of 30 days, the supplying party may terminate the supply of water to the supplied party until all arrearages in payment are received by the supplying party.
- 9. That it is the agreement of the parties that they shall permit a third party to cure a default of payment or other obligation and shall permit water distribution service to be reinstated upon such curative action.
- 10. That each of the parties to this Agreement does hereby grant to the other, his heirs, successors and assigns, such easements over, across and through the respective parcels as shall be reasonably necessary for the construction of the well, maintenance of water pipes, pumping equipment, mains, electrical wiring and conduit consistent with the purposes of this Agreement. These easements are described below, to wit: (Describe easements, if any and cite Warranty Deed)



- 11. That no party may install landscaping or improvements that will impair the use of said easements.
- 12. That each party shall have the right to act to correct an emergency situation and shall have access to the pertinent parcel in the absence of the other. An emergency situation shall be defined as the failure of any shared portion of the system to deliver water upon demand.
- 13. That only those parcels of real estate hereinabove described, and the dwellings located thereon shall be permitted to receive water from said well and pumping equipment; and each of the parties hereto does hereby covenant and agree that he/she will not allow or permit other persons,



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other than household guests, to take, draw, use or receive water from the well, nor permit other persons to connect to the pipes or mains serving his/her respective parcel.

- 14. That in the event the referenced well shall become contaminated and shall no longer supply water suitable for domestic consumption or shall no longer supply water adequate for the needs of all relevant parties, or in the event that another source of water shall become available to the respective parcels, then the rights and obligations of the parties created by this Agreement shall cease and terminate in accordance with the terms and conditions hereinafter described.
- 15. That upon the availability of such other source of water, it is contemplated that a reasonable time shall be allowed to effectuate the necessary connections to the new source.
- 16. That the respective rights and obligations of the parties shall continue until the parties who wish to terminate their participation in the Well Agreement have executed and filed a written statement of termination at the Office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Josephine, State of Oregon, and to the "supplying party". Upon termination of participation in this Agreement, the owner and occupant of each residence which is terminated from the Agreement shall have no further right to the use of the well. The terminated parties shall disconnect their respective lateral connection from said well system and shall have no further obligation to pay or collect for maintenance and related expenses incurred thereafter. The costs of disconnection from the well and water system shall be borne by the owner of the pertinent parcel.
- 17. That the undersigned parties shall permit well water sampling and testing by a responsible authority at the request of an undersigned party, state or local authority, mortgagee, or the United States of America, Rural Housing Services and the costs of such well tests are shared like any other expense.
- 18. That the said well and this Agreement, if amended, shall serve no more than four single family dwelling units or four parcels, notwithstanding the ability of the parties to make other amendments to this Agreement.
- 19. That the parties may amend this Agreement to assure equitable distribution of shared costs and responsibilities; however, this Agreement may not be amended during the term of a Federally-insured (direct) or guaranteed mortgage on any property served, except as provided herein, for the purpose of adding to the prescribed number of parties.
- 20. That the term of this Agreement shall be perpetual, except as herein limited.
- 21. That the benefits and burdens of this Agreement shall constitute a covenant running with the parcels of land herein described and shall be binding upon the heirs, successors in title and assigns of the parties hereto.
- 22. Any dispute under this Agreement shall be required to be resolved by binding arbitration of the parties hereto. If the parties cannot agree on an arbitrator, each party shall select one arbitrator

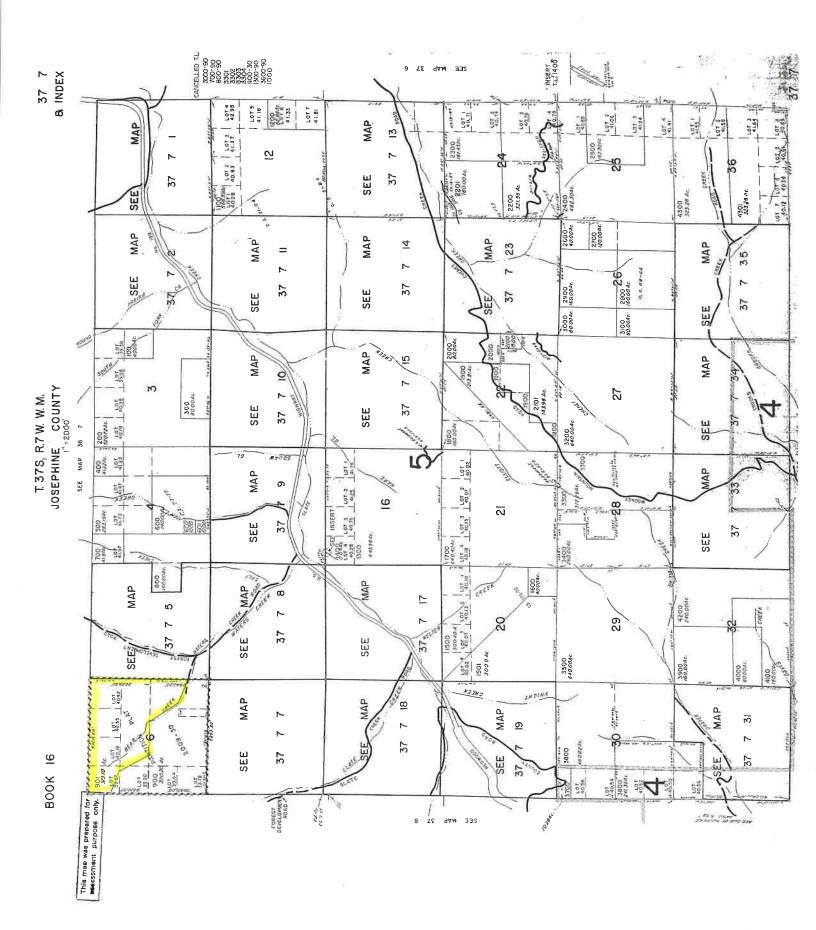
