1. Meeting was called to order by Don Schmidt, Vice Chairman.

- Reference was made to the September 12, 1978 evaluation by the CIAC. This
 evaluation discusses various concerns the committee has of the planning
 process.
- 3. Election of Committee Chairman and Vice Chairman:

- 4. Bikeway Plan.

Elvern Hall stated that the City presently has unused bike funds. He further stated that a good way to get a bike census within the City would be to check police registrations for bicycle licenses.

There was some discussion about the pro's and con's of eliminating parking on one side of the street for bike paths.

- (d) School

The committee mentioned that the High School may be able to help with the inventory needs of the bike plan.
