There being only one member of the Police Committee present no official business was conducted, however, several subjects were discussed.

- 1. Request from Buckley's Lockers for an additional 13' of restricted parking.

  No action taken. Chief Hawkins advised he will contact Mr. Buckley and remind him of the Planning Committee request that the driveway on Second Street be recurbed eliminating said driveway.
- 2. The ordinance providing for restricted parking at the intersections on Hancock Street was reviewed and it will be recommended that existing restrictions on the west side of each intersection on East Hancock be repealed.
- 3. Traffic control at the intersection of Sheridan and Washington Streets.

No action taken.

4. Discussion was held regarding the contract with Yamhill County for radio repair service.

No action taken.

5. Discussion regarding the number of complaints originating at the Fun Center on North Main Street.

No action taken.

- 6. Discussion regarding traffic congestion at First and River Streets on Sunday afternoons. It was recommended that the Police Department change this light on First Street to caution during the peak hours of traffic. Experiments with this have proven successful in eliminating congestion and hazards.
- 7. Discussion regarding parking problems on Fulton Street at the George Fox College gym.

No action taken.

8. Discussion was held regarding the proposed '78 - '79 Police Department Budget. No changes were recommended at this time.

Mr. Gilbert advised that total City Budget to be submitted to the people is \$290,000. in excess of the 6% limitation.
