- 1. Hawthorne Loop traffic problem speed bumps. Present were Larry Clark and Larry Eddens who are residents living on Hawthorne Loop. The discussion concerned whether speed bumps should be applied or whether stop signs which are presently installed can handle the problem. - 4. Discussed loading zones. Wait to see the report of the special committee appointed by the Mayor.
