Subjects discussed:

1. Liquor license application for Grandell's Restaurant  
Police Committee recommends approval
2. Chamber of Commerce letter regarding painting of parking spaces on Hancock Street from Main to River and elimination of crosswalks on First Street on the east side with intersecting streets.  
Action taken: Mr. Gilbert advises parking spaces will be so marked when weather is favorable and the Police Committee recommends that the eastern-most crosswalk on First Street at School Street be closed on a trial basis.
3. Four-way stop at Second and Blaine  
The Police Committee recommends no action at this time, however, future statistical information will be considered.
4. General discussion:
  - A. Chamber of Commerce request for elimination of parking meters.  
No action taken. City survey to be conducted.
  - B. Restricted parking at First and Washington and at First and Center Streets.  
Ordinance eliminates parking on the Northeast corner of these intersections.  
Will be repealed to comply with previous ordinance ammendment.
  - C. O.L.C.C. Liquor permits for dances at the Armory.  
The Committee feels that some method of procedure should be created to assure that adequate police protection is provided by dance license applicants.  
Further investigation will follow.
