Commercial Loading Zones

Purpose of the Committee was to determine and recommend to the City Council a policy on granting requests for loading zones within the Commercial area of Main to River Streets.

1. Restriction on loading zone limited to 6A.M. to 6 P.M., Monday through Saturday.
2. Occupancy in loading zone limited to 20 minutes at any one time.
3. Maximum footage for each zone limited to 22 feet; However, permit may be given for additional, that is 2 zones equal 44 feet.
4. Distance from intersection shall be considered, depending on location.
5. No loading zone shall be granted if applicant has access to an alley.
6. An individual loading zone shall not be granted for each applicant within the same block area. Several applicants within same block shall be encouraged to use the same loading zone.
7. Applicants need shall be considered on each application.
8. All applications for a commercial loading zone shall be referred to the Police Committee with authority to deny or approve the application. Upon approval of an application they shall advise the City Administrator of the location, size and other limitations for the loading zone.
9. A permit fee in amount of \$75.00 shall be charged for each zone (22 feet).
10. Upon termination of business at this location by the applicant the permit will be rescinded. However, the new owner may apply for a loading zone at the same location within 10 days. The permit fee then shall be \$25.00.
