The architects presented plans showing language and street details. Evaluations of the building were reviewed and changes to the north end were noted. The north facade is now presented more as a porch, without the strong pediment.

The position of a proposed fountain was questioned as in discussion it had been proposed for the area near the amphitheater. The architects responded that they felt there was a problem with putting too much into that area so were proposing that the fountain be moved a bit north.

The location of the book drop was discussed. Some concerns were that it be located so the driver could deposit books easily, that it would not interfere with traffic, that it be large enough to accommodate the anticipated use, and that there were no curbs so it will be easy for staff to roll loaded carts into the building.

At this point architect Dick Danielson, Board Chairman Leonard Attrell, and Librarian Doreen Turpen left for a short time to make an appearance at the Redevelopment Commission meeting since the application for funds for the Howard Street improvements was on that body's agenda.

Remaining committee members discussed the minor changes in the floor plan in the meeting room, the lower level work room and staff room, and the upper level office area.

Discussion continued when all members were again present. Pictures from the tour of Washington libraries were also presented at this time.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 p.m. with the Board to continue their meeting at 7:00 p.m. Thurs. Feb. 16 at the Library.
