Refunds to fee cardholders who move into Newberg were discussed. The consensus was to recommend to the full Board at the November meeting that a refund will be given if someone moves into Newberg within 30 days of paying the fee. Cardholders will apply for a refund, and it will be authorized by the Library Director with a check then mailed from the City. If this policy is approved at the November Board meeting it would be presented to the Finance Committee on November 24 and to the City Council for final approval in

December.

Wally Russell, representing the Library Foundation Mystery Play, urged

Board members to sell tickets for the November 14th event.

The Bulletin Board Policy was adopted as previously listed in the Circulation manual with Richard Gehrts making the motion and Dorothy Rogers providing the second. The general policy is that materials must be of a community nature and not for personal profit and only staff or volunteers will

place materials on the Boards.

Information: The State Library Annual Report was discussed.

Director's Report: In addition to the written Director's report, the following was discussed.

•The Americans with Disabilities Act will likely result in some minor

modifications, however major remodeling shouldn't be needed.
