I. Planning Commission.

There are three vacancies on the Planning Commission. We have four applications for the positions. An article appeared in the Newberg Graphic asking people to call in concerning the position. The committee wanted this to be placed on the May 4, 1992 City Council Agenda and ask the applicants to attend and see if the City can get more applications for Planning Commission members.

There should be recognition of the members that have resigned and request that a plaque be made and other matters be submitted to those people and that be done for them. A plaque should be given to Roger Veatch and other members should be recognized.

II. Fire Inspection Fee Committee.

The City has received the report from the Fire Inspection Fee Committee. The matter should be referred to the Chamber of Commerce to have input from them. The Committee should be thanked for their input and their recommendations.

III. Cable Television.

The franchise will be up in 1995. Legislation should be following concerning cable television. A review of Elvern's letter and the response was undertaken. This was a matter that we need to just be looking at.

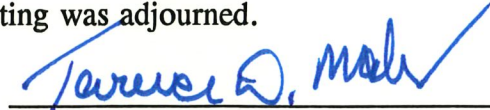
IV. Building Codes.
