Amazon Data Services, Inc.'s (ADS) PDX-4 facility was called in to the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program on June 27, 2024. DEQ approved ADS's CAO Emissions Inventory on January 31, 2025. ADS submitted the combined CAO Modeling Protocol (Protocol) and Risk Assessment Work Plan (Work Plan) on February 26, 2025. DEQ reviewed the Protocol and Work Plan and issued a Comment Letter on May 30, 2025. ADS submitted the revisions to the Protocol and Work Plan on June 26, 2025. DEQ has reviewed and approves the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) Protocol and Workplan prepared by Trinity Consultants on behalf of ADS for the PDX-4 facility submitted on June 26, 2025.

The next step in the CAO process is to submit a Risk Assessment by no later than one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of this letter, by **November 6, 2025**. [[OAR 340-245-0030\(1\)\(d\)\(ii\)](#)] Risk Assessment requirements are listed in [OAR 340-245-0050](#).
