The week of July 28, 2025, City crews and contractors will apply fog seal to all streets that received chip seal treatment last month. These fog seal projects will require short duration road closures between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at each location. Detours will be in place during work hours.

FOG SEAL - Fog sealing is an application of asphalt emulsion sprayed onto a pavement surface. The emulsion is diluted to the proper consistency to obtain complete coverage of the roadway. Fog sealing has been shown to extend the life of chip seal and scrub seal treatments.
