Cleaner Air Oregon Air Toxics Emissions Inventory Extension Request

Ms. Eagleson,

Columbia Forest Products, Inc. (Columbia) located in Klamath Falls, Oregon was notified on August 29, 2024 by Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) the facility was called into the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program. Per the call-in letter and OAR 340-245-0030(1)(a), the CAO Emissions Inventory Form (AQ520) is due by November 27, 2024.

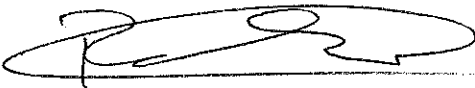
Columbia is respectfully submitting this request for an extension of the due date of ninety days (to February 25, 2025) as allowed by OAR 340-245-0030(3). Per the CAO regulations, the owner or operator must demonstrate progress in completing the submittal and a delay is necessary, for good cause shown by the owner or operator, related to obtaining more accurate or new data, performing additional analyses, or addressing changes in operations or other key parameters, any of which are likely to have a substantive impact on the outcomes of the submittal.

Columbia has made significant progress in gathering and compiling the information required for the air toxics emissions inventory, including collecting and reviewing emission factors, compiling chemical and material usages, screening safety data sheets (SDSs), and determining the potential to emit (PTE) operating scenarios.

The extension is requested to complete the information gathering and review of data, including further evaluation of emission factors, determining if additional source testing may be necessary, and screening of SDSs and the corresponding emissions calculations. The requested timeframe of ninety days is to accommodate the upcoming holiday schedules.
