RE: Extension Request for Risk Assessment Report Information Request—Eagle Foundry Company

Dear Julia:

Eagle Foundry Company (Eagle Foundry) received an email from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on July 8, 2025, requesting additional information for the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program. The email requested that Eagle Foundry submit meteorological data to the DEQ by July 18 2025, and additional data regarding toxic emission unit (TEU) release parameters to be provided by July 29, 2025. Eagle Foundry is providing the AERMET processing files and the raw meteorological data to the DEQ by ftp, meeting the submittal deadline of July 18<sup>th</sup>. Login details to access the ftp will be provided to you by email.

Eagle Foundry is requesting a 60-day extension to the July 29<sup>th</sup> deadline regarding information related to the TEU release parameters, resulting in a new submittal date of September 27, 2025. We have two of our key CAO team members unavailable to contribute to this phase of the project. One of them is on extended leave of absence until mid-August and the other is on intermittent PTO over the course of the next 7 weeks.

This letter is being submitted pursuant to OAR 340-245-0030(3). In accordance with OAR 340-245-0030(3)(a), Eagle Foundry has been responsive to all of the DEQ's requests, has an approved emissions inventory, and has submitted a combined Modeling Protocol, Work Plan, and Risk Assessment Report.
