TOPIC: Wastewater Treatment Plant Discharge Returned to Compliance

The discharge to the Columbia River from the City of The Dalles Wastewater Treatment Plant has returned to compliance with permit limits for *E. coli* as of August 8, 2025 at 10:05 p.m. The average of five samples taken throughout the day on August 7, 2025 at the City discharge point to the river were within limits. The delay in reading out the test results is due to the 24-

hour incubation time that the test requires.

Recent Columbia River samples show that *E. coli* levels at the sample locations were well below bacterial <u>criteria</u> set by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for freshwater recreation.

Signs which were placed at locations of public river access on the Oregon shore of the Columbia River, to warn of contaminated water, will be taken down the morning of Saturday, August 9, 2025.
