**In the Matter of an Order Reducing
Jail Bed Capacity until Installation of
Compliant Bunks**

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ORDER NO. 23595

WHEREAS, the bunk beds at the Curry County Jail have been deemed unsafe due to the presence of certain chemicals found in the metal frames and paint; and

WHEREAS, these conditions necessitate immediate remediation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of County employees and individuals in custody to temporarily reduce bunk capacity to allow for the safe removal and replacement of the affected materials; and

WHEREAS, Jail Commander Lieutenant Krohn has recommended a temporary reduction in bed capacity from 35 beds to 16 beds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Curry County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the temporary reduction of bed capacity to 16 beds, effective immediately, and continuing until the installation of new, compliant bunks is completed.
