NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS INVITATION TO BID SPRINGBROOK ROAD AND VILLA ROAD PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROJECT

Sealed bids for the **Springbrook Road & Villa Road Pavement Restoration Project** will be accepted until **1:00 p.m.** on **Day, the 21st day of August 2014**. This project is divided into two parts: **SCOPE A** includes emulsified asphalt chip seal for a stretch of North Springbrook Road, approximately 1,600 linear feet. Restoration of permanent striping and pavement marking will be performed by others. **SCOPE B** includes asphalt pavement taper grind and 2" overlay for a stretch of Villa Road, approximately 1,200 linear feet. Each **SCOPE** has its own mobilization, traffic control and separate insurance and bond requirements so that bidders may choose to bid on **SCOPE A**, or **SCOPE B**, or **both**. This project may be awarded in two separate contracts if the lowest and most responsive bids for each **SCOPE** are submitted by different bidders. The City reserves the right to increase, decrease, or completely eliminate quantities as set forth in the Bid Schedule of Prices.

The Engineer's Estimate for this project is in the range of \$110,000 to \$160,000. (SCOPE A: \$100,000 to \$145,000 and SCOPE B: \$10,000 to \$15,000.)

In order to be eligible for award of City of Newberg construction contracts, the bidders must provide documentation of their qualified and proven experience in any of the following work classifications: Asphalt Concrete Paving and Oiling; Aggregate Base; Temporary Traffic Control; Permanent Signing and Pavement Marking. Bidders who are prequalified with Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) or Oregon Department of Administrative Services (ODAS) shall provide proof of that prequalification with the bids. Bidders who do not have that prequalification but have performed acceptable work of similar nature and magnitude in other public jurisdictions within the last five years shall submit a list of those projects and their contact references with the bids. The City will reject bids from bidders who are not qualified or showing the necessary qualifications for this project.

This is a public works project subject to BOLI prevailing wage rates required by ORS 279C.800-870. By signing the bid, the bidder agrees to comply with those provisions which state that workers on public works projects are to be paid not prevailing less than current Region 2 BOLI website the rate of wage for (see http://www.oregon.gov/boli/WHD/PWR/Pages/July 2014 Index.aspx) In addition, all bidders shall be compliant with all tax laws and the successful bidder shall carry Workers' Compensation and Unemployment Insurance in accordance with ORS 656.001 through 656.794. No bid for a construction contract shall be considered unless the bidder is registered with the Construction Contractors Board as required by ORS 701.035 to 701.055.

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form completely filled out and signed, in a sealed envelope, clearly marked that it is a bid, and have the bidder's name and the project title on the outside of the envelope. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Newberg, Oregon, in an amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid submitted. Each bid must also be accompanied by a fully executed Non-Collusion Affidavit and First-Tier Disclosure Form. Failure to provide these documents will result in disqualification of the bid.

The City of Newberg reserves the right to reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements and may reject for good cause any or all bids on a finding of the City that it is in the public interest to do so; and to accept the bid which is in the best interest of the City. No bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the date set for opening. No prebid meeting is scheduled for this project.
