156 Ordinance To 29

On Ordenance granting unto O. B. Rowlings, his successors and assigns a right- and framchise to erect, construct- and maintains a systure of Water Works in the City of Lebanou. Line County, Origon

The People of the City of Lebauou do ordains as follows:

Sec 1

That There be and Thereby is hereby given and granted unto C. G. Rawlings, his successors and assigns the right- and franchise to erect-con-Street and maintain in The Streets and alleys of the City of Lebauow, Line County, Oregon all such Mains ditches, pipes, hydrauts and other fixtures as may be necessary and convenient or usually maintained for The purpose of carrying on a system of Water Works in said City and to construct; exet and maintain in said City all such Towers, reservois, buildings, machevery and other fixtures as may be necessary or convenient, or are commonly used for such purpose; Provided, however, that work on the systime of Water Works, herew mentioned shall be Commenced and reasonable progress made Thereon within one year from the approval of this Ordinance by The Wayor of said City, and that The aforesaid system of Wales Works shall be completed and put into operation within eighteen months after the approval of this Ordinance by the Mayor of the City

This grant is made to said O & Rawlings, his successors and assignes for the period of fifteen (15) years from the approval of this Ordinance by the Mayor upon the express condition that the said O. G. Rawlings, his successors and assignes shall at all lines during said period of fifteen (15) years after excline of said systems of Water Works furnish to the City

of Lebauou free and without any charge therefor and as a consideration for this grant and franchese all the necessary water for the use of the Council Chamber and The officer for the City authoretees, together with the necessary pipes, hydrauls and fixtures for the convenient use of said water in said Council Chamber and City offices and a refusal or neglect to furnish said water and fixtures for said Council Chamber or City offices on the part of C. G. Rawlings, his successors, core - assights shall immediately make null and void This grant or franchise and The same shall There upon revert to the Cely of Lebanow

De 2 The said C. G. Kawlings, his successors or assigned shall erect construct and maintain all such maine, pipes, detches, hydraule and other fixtures in such a manner as well not interfere with the free and unobstructive use of the Streets pipes, shall be laid at such defth as the City vuncil may designate +

Whenever it shall become neccessary in the any such pipe, or the erection of any such bydraut to interfere in any manner with any Street or alley, the said C. G. Rawlings, his successors or assigne shall without delay put such Street or alley in as good condition as it was before broken, dug up or disturbed, and shall at once removed all surplus Earth and rubbish from such Etriet or allega

Within sixty days after the approval of this Sec 5

Ordinauce by the Mayor, the said C. G. Rawlings, or his authorized agust shall file with the Recorder of the City of Lebanow, his written acceptance of this Ordinauces, together with all of its conditions and provisions and in event of his failure so to do, This Ordinauce shall be vide and of no effect
