

Ordinance No 34

An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of Fire hose and providing the mode and manner of paying therefor

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Sec 1 That The Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in the name of and for the use of the City of Lebanon to purchase from A. G. Long of Portland, Oregon, three hundred (300) feet of four (4) ply "White Anchor" fire hose, including the "Higbee Coupling" delivered at Lebanon, Oregon, at a price of not more than one and ten (\$1.10) dollar and ten cents per foot; to be paid for within nine (9) months from the 14th day of March 1894, with interest after date at eight (8) per cent per annum.

The Mayor and The Recorder are hereby directed and authorized to enter into and execute a contract in writing, in duplicate, with the said A. G. Long of Portland, Oregon, for and in behalf of and in the name of the City of Lebanon, in manner and form to properly carry into effect the foregoing provisions of this section.

Sec 2 That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the Funds in the City Treasury for the purpose of paying for said hose, in the manner herein provided, the sum of three hundred and thirty (330) dollars, or so much thereof as may be required, and a warrant, drawing eight (8) per cent interest per annum shall be given said Long, bearing date on the day the said hose is accepted by the City and payable nine (9) months after date.

Sec 3 This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its approval by The Mayor
