An Ordinance to Amend Section - 2 of Ordinance No 24 entitled "An Ordinance to provide for Licensing, Taping, regulating and restraining the sale of and disposal of spirituous, malt, or vinuous Liquors, and prohibiting the sale or disposal of the same without first obtaining a License therefor from the City Council; and to regulate Bars, Barrooms, drinking shops and tippling houses; and to provide for the punishment of any violation thereof; And to repeal all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith of the City of Lebanon Linn County Oregon, duly enacted by the City Council and duly approved by the Mayor thereof on the 23rd day of February 1892.

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows.

- Sec (1) That Section - 2 - of the above entitled Ordinance No 24 Entitled, "An Ordinance to provide for licensing Taping, regulating, and restraining the sale and disposal of Spirituous, Malt, or vinuous Liquors, and prohibiting the sale or disposal of the same without first obtaining a License therefor from the City Council, and to regulate Bars, Barrooms, drinking shops and tippling houses, and to provide for the punishment of any violation thereof, and to repeal Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith of the City of Lebanon, Linn County

Oregon duly enacted by the City Council, and duly approved by the Mayor thereof, on the 23rd day of February 1892, be and the same is hereby Amended so as to read as follows

Sec (2)

"That every person or persons applying for a license to vend, sell or dispose of spirituous, malt, or Vinuous Liquor or Liquors in less quantities, than one Gallon, within the Corporate Limits of the City of Lebanon, in Linn County Oregon shall first pay to the Treasurer of the City of Lebanon the sum of Four Hundred Dollars annually taking the duplicate receipt of the Treasurer therefor."

That Ordinance No 24 shall govern the issuing of Liquor Licences in all respects - save only as by this Ordinance amended

Sec (3)

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed

Sec (4)

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval of the Mayor
