

Ordinance No 38.

An Ordinance to tax and license steam wood saws, defining what are steam wood saws, and to regulate and restrain the movements of steam engines, within the City of Lebanon, and to provide for the punishment of any violation hereof.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1, The owner or proprietor of any steam wood saw following the business of sawing wood within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon either as his sole occupation or in connection with other business, shall pay into the City Treasury the sum of \$20⁰⁰ annually. Any person, who, with the aid of a steam saw, shall saw or offer to saw wood within the City limits shall be deemed the owner or proprietor of a steam wood saw, within the meaning of this Ordinance.

Section 2, The owner or proprietor of any steam wood saw before following his said business within the City limits, shall first take out a license therefor in accordance with Ordinance No 27. (37) of the said City of Lebanon, which said Ordinance is for this purpose made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 3, The owner or proprietor of any steam wood saw, who shall saw or offer to saw any wood with the aid of any steam wood saw within the City limits of Lebanon, without first obtaining a license therefor as herein provided, shall upon conviction before the Recorder's Court, be fined not less than \$10⁰⁰ nor more than ~~50⁰⁰~~ or be imprisoned in the City jail not less than five ^{days} nor more than twenty-five days.

Section 4, This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the City Council on the 25th day of March 1895.
