

Ordinance No 39.

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Amended
An Ordinance to Amend sections 10 and 13 of Ordinance No. 13, Entitled "An Ordinance to protect the public health and to prevent the spread of dangerous or contagious diseases within the Corporate limits of the City of Lebanon.

The people of the City of Lebanon, do ordain as follows:

Section 7. That section 10 of Ordinance No 13 - entitled "an ordinance to protect the public health and to prevent the spread of dangerous or contagious diseases within the Corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows to wit:-

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Section 10. The occupant of any store, house, tenement or building in said City wherein any person may have been sick of Small-pox, diphtheria, Cholera, scarlet fever or any other dangerous or contagious disease, shall on the death or recovery of such person, from such disease, forthwith destroy, by burning or burying all the clothing worn by such person during such sickness and shall likewise forthwith, thoroughly cleanse and purify all the bed clothing beds and all other articles used or placed in or about the house wherein such diseased

person was kept; under the supervision of the Health Officer of the City, and thoroughly cleanse and

purify the room, and house; store tenement or building in which such sick person was confined during such sickness; and the health officer shall see that the provisions of this section are strictly enforced; and if the occupant of ^{any} Building ~~wherein~~ in which there shall have been a case of small-pox, diphtheria, Cholera scarlet fever or any other dangerous or contagious disease shall vacate such building without first having cleansed and purified the same as herein provided, then it shall be unlawful for the owner to lease or rent such building or any part thereof, to any person until after the same shall have been thoroughly cleansed and purified under the supervision of the health officer of the City.

Section 2. That section 13 of the aforesaid Ordinance No. 13 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows to wit:

Section 13. No person affected with small-pox, Cholera, diphtheria, scarlet fever or any other dangerous or contagious disease, nor any person attending upon or otherwise coming in contact with any person affected with small-pox, Cholera, diphtheria, scarlet fever or any other dangerous or contagious disease, in such manner as to render him liable

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to communicate the disease, shall go upon any public street or alley or other public place within the City or in any way mingle with people not affected with such disease, until all danger of infection or contagion shall have passed; and then only when duly released from quarantine by the proper officer. Provided however that nothing herein contained shall apply to practicing Physicians. But all physicians within the City limits shall use the greatest care and precaution to prevent the spread of any contagious or infectious disease therein, and shall report in writing to the Committee on health and police the time at which in his opinion any and all patients, and ^{person} attending upon any such patient, under his care affected with any disease enumerated herein, can go at large without endangering the health of the public.

Section 3. All parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
