

Ordinance No. 42.

Repealed

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 35 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, duly enacted by the City Council and duly approved by the Mayor, October 2nd 1894, entitled "An Ordinance to amend section 2 of Ordinance No. 24, entitled "An Ordinance to provide for licensing taxing, regulating and restraining the sale and disposal of spirituous malt or vinous liquors and prohibiting the ^{sale} or disposal of the same without first having obtained a license therefor from the City Council; And to regulate bars, bar-rooms, drinking shops and tippling houses; and to provide for the punishment of any violation thereof and to repeal all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith" of the City of Lebanon Linn County, Oregon, duly enacted by the City Council and duly approved by the Mayor thereof on the 23rd day of February 1892. And to amend section 2 of Ordinance No. 24 entitled "An Ordinance to provide for licensing taxing regulating and restraining the sale and disposal of spirituous malt or vinous liquors and prohibiting the sale or disposal of the same without first obtaining a license therefor from the City Council; and to regulate bars, bar-rooms, drinking shops and tippling houses and to provide for the ^{punishment of any} violation thereof and to repeal all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith" of the City of Lebanon Linn County Oregon duly enacted and approved by the mayor on the 23rd day of February, 1892. And to fix the amount of license for the sale of spirituous, malt or vinous liquors in said City.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No 35, being the ordinance first set forth in the title hereof be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That section 2 of Ordinance No 24 being the ordinance next set forth in the title hereof be and the same is hereby amended so as to read and section 2 of Ordinance No 24 shall read as follows to wit: "Section 2.

That every person applying for a license to sell spirituous malt or vinous liquors in less quantities than one gallon shall pay to the Treasurer of the City of Galena aforesaid the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars annually or the sum of Four Hundred ^{Dollars} semiannually taking the duplicate receipt of the Treasurer therefor.

Section 3. That Ordinance No 24. above referred to shall govern the issuing of liquor licenses in all respects save only as by this Ordinance amended.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
