

Ordinance No 45.

An Ordinance to repeal section ten (10) of Ordinance No 37 Entitled "An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No 27 and to license tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing license therefor" and to prohibit the keeping of billiard or pool rooms and nickle-in-the-slot machines within the limits of the City of Lebanon and to provide for the punishment of any violation thereof.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section One: That section ten (10) of Ordinance No 37 Entitled "an Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No 27 and to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing license therefor" be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section Two: That it shall be unlawful for any person to keep any billiard or pool room within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon. Every place or building where billiards, pool or other games are played where balls and cues are used shall be held to be a billiard or pool room within the meaning of this Ordinance. Provided that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any person or persons who may have at the date of the passage of this Ordinance any license regularly issued by the proper officer or officers of the said City of Lebanon. whereby he or they are

permitted to run operate or maintain such billiard or pool room: provided further that this ordinance section shall not apply to saloons licensed under the Ordinances of this city where the proprietors are permitted to keep certain tables mentioned in the ordinance under which such person or persons obtained licence therefor.

Any person or persons found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this section shall upon conviction before the Recorder's Court be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars nor less than Twenty-five dollars or imprisoned in the City jail not more than Thirty days nor less than twelve days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Recorder.

Section 3. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep in his or their place of business any melle-in-the-slot machine or other device whereby any person shall or may put in any coin or piece of money and have any chance of getting any more value in return for the money put in such machine than the amount of such money either in money or goods or merchandise of any kind whatever or shall in any way gamble or trade with the use of any such machine.

Any person or persons found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this section shall upon conviction before the Recorder's Court be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars nor less than Twenty-five dollars or by imprisonment in the City jail not

more than thirty days nor less than
twelve days or both such fine and
imprisonment in the discretion of the
Recorder.

Section 4, This Ordinance shall be in
full force and effect on and after
its approval by the Mayor of the City
of Lebanon Linn County, Oregon.
