Ordinance No. 46.

An Ordinance prohibiting the selling, giving away or otherwise disposing of any spirituous, malt or vinous liquors in less quantities than one gallon & to prohibit the keeping of a bar, barroom, drinking shop or tippling house in the City of Lebanon & to provide for the punishment of any violation thereof & to repeal all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That no person shall keep a bar, barroom, drinking shop, tippling house or saloon in the City of Lebanon.

Sec. 2. That no person shall sell, vend, give away or otherwise dispose of any spirituous, malt or vinous liquors in less quantities than one gallon within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon. And giving an other person a drink of, or treating him or her to, a drink of spirituous, malt or vinous liquors shall also be a violation of this Section.

Sec. 3. That any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of the City of Lebanon be fined not less than Twenty-five (25) Dollars or more than One Hundred (100) Dollars

and be imprisoned in the City jail not less than Ten (10) Days nor more than Thirty (30) days.

Sec. 4. That All Ordinances & parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
