

Amended

An Ordinance to amend Section 41 of an Ordinance Numbered 33, of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, entitled, "An Ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same, and providing for the punishment thereof; and to repeal Ordinance No. 3."

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:—

Sec. 1.

That Section 41 of Ordinance Numbered 33, of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, entitled, "An Ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same, and providing for the punishment thereof; and to repeal Ordinance No. 3," be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:—

Section 41. No person shall ride a bicycle or tricycle or any side walk in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, provided, however that this section shall not apply to any invalid or cripple who shall use such vehicle for the purpose of travel.

Any person violating the provision of this section shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, be fined not less than ten (10) dollars nor more than twenty five (25) dollars, or be imprisoned in the City jail not less than five (5) days nor more than ten (10) days.

Sec. 2.

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3.

That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval of the Mayor.
