RE: Microchip Technology – Emission Inventory Extension Request

Dear Julia DeGagne:

Microchip Technology, Inc. (Microchip) received a letter dated June 30, 2025 from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) officially calling in the facility located in Gresham, Oregon (the Gresham Facility) to the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program. Per the letter, Microchip is required to submit an emission inventory and required supporting documentation detailing toxic air contaminant emissions no later than September 29, 2025.

Due to the complexity of Microchip's semiconductor facility operations, we are formally requesting an extension of 90 days to submit the emissions inventory, with a new submittal deadline of December 29, 2025. This extension will allow us the time needed to provide accurate and complete information for Oregon DEQ's review, and we hope will ultimately minimize any changes to the inventory following its submittal.

In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 340-245-0030(3), Microchip has made substantial progress to date on preparing the emission inventory. Among other things, Microchip has engaged Trinity Consultants to assist Microchip in identifying all toxic emission units at the Gresham Facility and preparing accurate and complete emissions calculations for the inventory. Microchip requires additional time to work with Trinity to refine the facility's working draft inventory, including without limitation to verify emission factors, confirm emission release points, and develop requested potential maximum emissions for use in the inventory.

Microchip would be pleased to discuss its current progress on the inventory and remaining work with Oregon DEQ.
