 An Ordinance relating to the establishing of grade of certain streets in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows—

Sec I.

The established grade of the following named streets of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by surveyor Barr and filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn Co. Oregon, on the 6th day of June, 1899:—

Main Street and North Main Street from beginning to end, Oak Street from Main Street West to corporate limits, Sherman Street from Main Street West to Third Street, Third Street from Sherman Street North to Ash Street, Academy Street from Main Street West to Montague St, Montague Street from Academy Street North to Tangent Street, Tangent Street from Montague Street, West to Corporate limits, Grove Street from Bridge Street North to Wheeler Street.

Sec II.

Gutters of streets shall be ten feet from edge of streets or line of lots abutting thereon or adjoining, leaving streets forty feet wide from gutter to gutter.

Sec III.

The round of grade from gutter to center of street shall be eight tenths of a foot and the gravel put thereon shall be extra. This shall be the grade only where dirt and gravel are used, but if planks stone or other pavement is used, the round shall be five tenths

of a foot.

Sec IV

All ordinances or parts of ordinances not consistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec V

This Ordinance shall take effect ^{on} after its approval by the Mayor
