

Ordinance No. 51

An Ordinance to amend Section 2 of Ordinance Number 37, of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, entitled an "An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance Number 27, and to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing license therefor," passed the City Council April 1st, 1895.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:—

Sec I

That Section 2 of Ordinance Number 37 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, entitled "An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance Number 27, and to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing license therefor," passed by the City Council April 1st, 1895 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:—

Sec II

Hawkers, the owner or keeper of any cane-rack, doll-rack, egg or ball, ~~or~~ throwing target, circular sawing, merry-go-round or wheel-of-fortune shall each pay a license of Twenty five dollars a day for each day in which they shall conduct their business within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn Co, Oregon.

Any person who offers goods, wares or merchandise for sale by out-cry upon the streets or alleys, or who conducts his business from a stand, booth or vehicle upon the streets or alleys, of said City, shall be deemed a hawker, within

the meaning of this Ordinance.

Sec 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its approval by the Mayor
