

each month. Such Report - to include a correct and particular description of all such repairing for each month. beginning with the first - meeting in one month and ending with the first meeting in the next - and so on during his term of office

Section 5 The Town Marshal shall have power to appoint - by written appointment - filed with the Recorder. and employ a deputy who shall hold his office a Deputy Marshal subject to the orders and requirement of the Town Marshal in accordance with and subject to the provisions of Town ordinance in force and such Deputy shall take an oath to faithfully demean himself in office

Section 6 This Ordinance to be in force from and after five days after its publication by posting.

Ordinance No 8

Relating to the qualification and duties of Town Treasurer

The People of the Town of Lebanon do ordain as follows

Section 1 Before entering upon the duties of Town Treasurer he shall file with the Recorder a certificate of his Election with his oath

of office endorsed thereon that he will faithfully demean himself in office and also a bond to the Town of Lebanon in the sum of five hundred dollars with Sureties to be approved by the Town council condition that he will faithfully discharge the duties of town treasurer account for and pay over all moneys and turn over to his successor all books papers or property belonging to the town that may come into his hands by virtue of his office as such Treasurer

Section 2 The Treasurer shall reside and keep an office within the Town Limits and shall pay all orders issued to him by the Town Recorder and signed by the President of the council in the order they are presented for payment from the funds of the Town Treasury and he shall pay no money out of the Town Treasury except on orders so issued and signed.

Section 3 He shall at the end of each quarter and at the last regular meeting for the year or at any time when required by the Town council to do so make report to the Town council of his transactions as Treasurer he shall at the time of making such report return to the Town council all vouchers paid and cancelled by him which cancelling shall be done at the time of payment by writing or stamping on the face of such order the word paid in large letters with the date of payment he shall include in his report an account of all money and property in his hands as Town Treasurer and turn the same over to his successor when he shall be duly qualified

Section 4 The Town Treasurer shall receive one per cent on all money received and one and a half per cent for all money paid out by him as Town Treasurer and his account shall be audited and paid as other as other accounts against the Town

Section 5 When any Town warrant shall be presented to the Treasurer and there is no money in the Treasury to pay the same the Treasurer shall endorse on the back of said warrant presented and not paid for want of funds also the time of making said endorsement and he shall keep a record of such warrants in a book kept for that purpose whenever the Treasurer shall pay any warrants so endorsed he shall cancel the same as other warrants are canceled by him and endorse the same on the book of endorsed orders
