

Ordinance No 10

Relating to the Material used and manner
of Building sidewalks and crosswalks

The People of the Town of Lebanon
do Ordain as follows

Section 1

If not otherwise provided for by the Town
council the sidewalk on Main Street
~~between~~ the North side of Maple Street
and the South side of Ash Street shall
be eight-foot wide: and constructed as
follows to be laid on bearings four by four
inches to be laid on the ground or when
necessary on pillars of stone or brick six
feet apart to contain 4 tiers of stringers
to be two by six inches to be laid at equal
distance apart and secured by being nailed
together with thirty $\frac{1}{2}$ nails the outer stringer
to be laid within two inches of the outer
edge of the decking the decking to be one
and one half inches thick red or yellow
fir square edged and evenly fitted and
nailed to the stringers with twelve $\frac{1}{2}$
Nails The crosswalks within the above
limits to be five feet wide of red or yellow
fir three inches ~~thick~~ to be laid on bearings
three by six inches five feet apart the
edges to be leveled and a layer of gravel
six ^{inches} deep and four feet ^{inclined} wide on each side
of said crosswalk then to all sidewalks to
be not more than eight inches to six
feet running measure

Section 2

on the balance of main street and all
other streets of the Town the sidewalks

shall be five feet and four inches wide to be laid on bearings four by four inches to be laid on the ground and contain three tiers of stringers to be two by six inches to be laid on the edges at equal distance apart and securely nailed with thirty ~~cl~~ nails the decking to be the same thickness and laid the same as provided in section one of this ordinance

Section 3 All crosswalks to be the same as provided in section one of this ordinance

Section 4 All owners of lots or parts of lots shall be required to build a sidewalk adjoining their respective lot or lots also the crossways of the alleys adjoining the same the expense of building the alleys crossways to be equally divided between the property owners on each side of said alley the expense of building the crosswalks shall be paid by the owners of lots or parts of lots in the block where such crosswalks are built to be divided according to the number of feet they own in said block fronting on said street so improved

Section 5 Whenever the town council shall order a sidewalk to be built adjoining any lot or lots within the town limits and the owner or owners of said lot or lots shall neglect or refuse to build the same within the time specified in said order then it shall be the duty of the Town Marshal to build or cause the same to be built and the expense of building

Said sidewalk shall be a lien on such lot or lots until paid.

Section 6 If the owner or owners of said lot or lots shall neglect or refuse to pay the Marshal the cost of building within thirty days after the same is completed it shall be the duty of the Recorder upon the application of the Marshal to issue a warrant under his hand commanding the Marshal in the name of the town of Lebanon to levy upon and sell said lot or lots or so much thereof as may be necessary to satisfy the amount of building said sidewalk together with the costs of collecting the same.

Section 7 The warrant so issued shall have the same effect as an execution against any person firm or corporation and all proceedings had upon it shall be conducted by the Marshal as is or may be provided by law of this state upon a warrant to any sheriff issued by the county court of any county for the collection of state and county taxes by the sale of real or personal property.

Section 8 All owners of lots or parts of lots adjoining a street that is ordered by the town council to be improved with a sidewalk shall before building such sidewalk is hereby required to dig a ditch to be of sufficient width and depth to drain said street the digging of said ditch to be under the supervision of the road supervisor the dirt coming from said ditch to be thrown away.

from said ditch so it will not obstruct the drainage of said street. Said ditch to be under the sidewalk

Section 9. Any person building an awning is hereby required to set the posts supporting the same on the extreme outer edge of the sidewalk all awnings now built shall be changed so as to conform to the provisions of this section

Section 10 This ordinance to be in force from and after five days after its publication by posting
