

Ordinance No 11

Relating to constructing and Repairing
Side Walks and cross Walks and improving
Streets and alleys.

The People of the
Town of Lebanon do ordain:

Sect 1. It shall be the duty of all
owners of any Real Property Lot or
lots or parts of lots within the
Town limits when Required so to do,
beg the Council to build construct
and Repair the Side Walks adjoining
their respective Real Property Lot lots
or parts of lots - also to construct
and Repair the cross ways for the
Alleys, and improve the alleys
adjoining the same. the expense of
constructing and Repairing alley cross
ways and improving Alleys to be
divided equally among between
the property holders on each side of
said Alleys, also to open grade
pave or Grate plans or otherwise
to improve and keep in Repair
the Streets cross Walks and Street
crossings opposite and adjoining
said Real Property Lot lots or parts
of lots to enter of said Streets.
The Same to extend each way to enter
of the Public Square, or Block where one
Street crosses another according to
their frontage.

Sect 2nd - That when a Majority of Property
 holders, on a Street shall petition the
 Council to have said Street improved
 by grading paving plankings or Graveling
 the Council shall order the same to be
 done by the Property holders thereof on
 said Street - giving them a reasonable
 length of time in which to complete
 the same, and if it becomes necessary
 for the Public Good to improve any
 Street within the Town of Lebanon
 and the Property holders owners on
 said Street - Neglect - or Refuse to petition
 the Council for the improvement of
 said street, the Council shall order said
 Street or Streets to be improved by the
 Property holders on said street or Streets
 as the Council may deem Necessary.

Sect 3 - That - Whenever the Council shall
 order a Side Walk or cross Walk
 Constructed or Repaired, or Alley improved
 or Street - cross Walk, or Street - Crossing
 opened, graded paved graveled plankings
 or otherwise Constructed or Repaired
 adjoining opposite or adjacent - to
 any real Property lot - lots or parts
 of lots within the Town limits
 and the owners of said Real Property
 lots or parts of lots Neglect or Refuse
 to construct - Repair or otherwise
 improve the same as ordered
 within the time specified in said
 order, then it shall be the duty of
 the Marshall to have the same done

Without delay and the costs of improvements & repairs shall be a lien on said Property until paid.

Sect 4 That if the owner or owners of any Real Property lot-lots or parts of lots shall Neglect or Refuse to pay the Marshall the costs of constructing repairing or Grading paving or otherwise improving the same, within Thirty Days after the same is completed, it shall be the duty of the Recorder Upon the Application of the Marshall, to issue a Warrant Under his hand Commanding the Marshall in the Name of the Town of Lebanon to Levy upon and sell said Real Property lot-lots or parts of lots or so much thereof as may be Necessary to Satisfy the amount of constructing repairing Graveling grading paving or otherwise Improving said Side Walks or Cross Walks, Streets or Alleys together with the costs of Making said Levy and Sale and said Warrant shall be executed and the Property thereunder in the Same Manner as Property is Sold for Town Taxes.

Sect 5- It shall be the duty of all persons who shall desire to convey any Wagon or Pass any Beast of burden over any Side walks in front of any Building or lot within the Town limits, to build or cause to be built - and kept in repair a good substantial crosswalk in the Side walk at such place of crossing, the full width of the Side walk and may be allowed to construct a bridge or apron from said cross-walk to the Street - such cross walk shall Not be built with more than three inches slant or incline to six feet, over which Waggons or Beasts of burden may be allowed to pass the same as over street and alley cross walks.

Sect 6- all Public Thoroughfares within the Corporate limits of the Town of Lebanon over Forty Feet in width are declared to be Streets for the purpose of this Ordinance
