

Ordinance No. 13

To Restrain Hogs from running at large
within the Corporate Limits of the Town

The People of the Town of Lebanon do
Ordain as follows

Section 1 It shall not be lawful for any Hog or Hogs to run at large within the Corporate Limits of the Town. It shall be the duty of the Town Marshal upon his own knowledge or information that any hog or hogs are running at large within the Corporate Limits of the Town to immediately take up and confine said hog or hogs in a good and secure place

Section 2 Immediately after taking and confining any hog or hogs the Town Marshal shall post up three notices in three of the most public places in the Town describing the marks and color of said hog or hogs and in said notices advertise said hog or hogs for sale at public auction three days after the date of said notice, unless the owner of said hog or hogs shall come forward and pay the charges and take them away

Section 3 The Marshal shall on the day advertised proceed to sell said hog or hogs so confined to the highest bidder for cash in hand and pay the proceeds of such sale over to the Town Treasurer taking his receipt therefor and shall file with the Recorder his report of such sale and the expenses thereof.
