

Ordinance No. 14

Relating to the
Establishment of Road District, Appointment
of Street and Road Supervisor, his duties and
the Assessment Levy and Collection of Poll
and Property Tax for Street and Road purposes
within the town limits

The People of the
Town of Lebanon do Ordain as follows

Section 1

That the Corporate limits of the Town
of Lebanon shall be and is hereby constituted
a separate Road District

Section 2

That the Town Council is hereby empowered
to appoint a suitable person as Street and
Road Supervisor of the Town of Lebanon, whose
duty it shall be to collect all taxes for road
purposes within the Corporate limit of the Town
of Lebanon and who may be removed at any
regular meeting of the Town Council for
dereliction of duty

Section 3

The Recorder shall cause
a certified copy of such order appointing
such Supervisor to be delivered to him which
shall be notice of his Appointment and evidence
of his Authority to act as such and that said
supervisor shall also file with the Recorder
an oath subscribed by him that he will faithfully
and honestly discharge the duties of Street
and Road Supervisor

Section 4

That each male
resident of the Town of Lebanon between
the ages of Twenty one and Fifty years
shall be required to pay the sum of
Two Dollars as Poll Tax each year to the

Street and Road Supervisor and by him applied on the streets and roads within the corporate limits of said town

Section 5 In addition to Section 4 of this Ordinance there shall be a levy of Two Dollars for each One Thousand Dollars as a street and road tax upon the assessable property within the town limits, the same to be used by the Supervisor upon the streets and roads within the town limits

Section 6 It shall be the duty of the Street and Road Supervisor on or before the 20th day of March of each year to obtain the names and make out in alphabetical order a list of all persons subject to Poll and property tax for street and road purposes residing within the corporate limits and file the same with the Recorder whose duty it shall be within ten days to ascertain by assessment the amount of Poll and property tax for street and road purposes and affix to each name the amount of such poll and property tax as provided in Sections 4 & 5 of this Ordinance of all persons residing or who have property within the town limits

Section 7 On or before the expiration of five days thereafter the Recorder shall make out a complete list of the names of all persons liable for poll and property tax within the town limits with the amount against each and deliver such list with the amount ~~against~~ under his hand and town seal to said Street and Road Supervisor who shall proceed to collect said amounts

for street and road purposes and expend the same upon the streets and roads within the corporate limits as provided in this Ordinance provided whenever the Supervisor shall from any cause have neglected or omitted to place on his list within the time required by this ordinance he shall at any time afterwards place the name of any such person on the list received from the Recorder with the amount of Poll and property tax which assessment shall in all respects be as valid as if made in due time

Section 8 The Assessment of real and personal property for street and road purposes by the Recorder shall be the same as provided for in Section 2 of Ordinance 5 for the purpose of assessing levying and collecting town tax and any person aggrieved by said assessment ^{for the payment of the same} when called upon by the Supervisor of street and roads may appear before the Council at the next regular meeting thereafter in person or by verified statement of facts filed with the Recorder as provided in Section 3 of Ordinance 5 relating to assessment levy and collection of town taxes and have the same adjusted as therein provided

Section 9 If any person shall fail or refuse to pay to the street and road Supervisor the amount of Poll and property tax for street and road purposes as provided in this Ordinance within three days after demand of the same by the Supervisor he shall incur a penalty of double the amount of tax to be added thereto, the same to be recovered by action against the offender brought before the Recorder's Court in the name of the Town

of Lebanon and the judgment rendered in such case shall be the amount of tax penalty and costs of said action

Section 10

Such Street and Road Supervisor shall keep an account of the number of days work performed on the roads and streets and by whom performed and the amount paid each and every one doing work under his supervision Also an account of all money money collected as poll and property tax for street and road purposes within the corporate limits and the expenditure of the same or any part thereof for any and all purposes and said Supervisor shall on the first meeting in December of each year present his account to the Council for examination and settlement and shall be charged with any unexpended balance in his hands

Section 11

If any Street and Road Supervisor shall neglect to perform the duties required of him by this Ordinance or who shall under any pretence whatever give or sign any receipt for road and street tax unless the money shall have been paid or pay out money to any person for labor or material, where no labor or material has been rendered or furnished shall forfeit for every such offense not less than five nor more than fifty Dollars for the use of the Town of Lebanon to be recovered before the Recorder as other penalties in the name of the Town of Lebanon and it is hereby made the duty of the Marshal to sue for the same

Section 12

Such Street and Road Supervisor

shall receive for each day necessarily employed in the performance of any of the duties required by this ordinance one and above the amount due from him for poll and property tax for streets and roads the sum of Two Dollars and a half per day and said amount may be held in possession by said Supervisor as compensation for his services

Section 13

This Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after five days after its publication by posting
