

Ordinance Bill No. 16

Relating to the Improvement of Grant Street

The People of the Town
of Lebanon do ordain as follows

Section 1. That Grant Street be improved by property
holders on each side in accordance with
Ordinance No. 11 from the West Side of Main
Street the West side of Second Street by
grading with gravel on a grade with Main
Street and said grade to be not less than four
inches of gravel at edge of sidewalks, also
to be ditched sufficient to drain said street
under sidewalks on each side

Section 2. That Grant
Street be improved from West side of Second
Street to Railroad by grading with gravel
in center eight inches and 16 feet in
width, also ditched on each side of said
street sufficient to drain said street

Section 3. That Grant Street be improved by side
walk on south side from Main Street
to West side of Second Street as required
by general Ordinance for the making and
constructing sidewalks

Section 4. That this
Ordinance to be in full force and
effect from and after, five days
Publication by posting
