

Ordinance No 20

An Ordinance to amend Section 4
of Ordinance No 14, Relating to the
Establishment of Road District, Appointment
of Road Supervisor and the Levy of
Poll Tax

The People of the Town of Lebanon
do Ordain as follows

Section One, That each male resident of the Town
of Lebanon, between the ages of Twenty
One and Fifty years, except active
Fireman of any Company, for one year
prior to the assessing of taxes shall
be required to pay the sum of Two Dollars
as Poll Tax each year to the Street and
Road Supervisor and by him applied
on the Streets and Roads within the
Corporate limits of said Town

Section Two, This Ordinance to be in full
force from and after five days
publication by posting
