

Ordinance No 2021  
 Relating to  
 the Fire Department of the Town of  
 Lebanon and the Care and Control of  
 Fire Engine and Apparatus

The People of the Town of Lebanon  
 do Ordain as Follows

- Sec. 1. That the Fire Department of the Town of Lebanon shall consist of the Lebanon Engine Co No. 1 as now constituted and such other companies as may hereafter be organized under the direction and consent of the Town Council
- Sec. 2. That said Engine Co No 1 shall consist of not less than Twenty active Firemen and the officers of said Company shall consist of a President Secretary, Treasurer Foreman 1<sup>st</sup> Assistant Foreman and 2<sup>nd</sup> Assistant Foreman. The election and duties of said officers shall be as prescribed by the Constitution rules and by laws of said company in force.
- Sec. 3. That the names of said officers shall be certified to the Town Council by the Secretary and President of said Engine Co No 1 within ten days after each annual election and placed on file in the Office of the Recorder
- Sec. 4. That the Hand Engine and all fire Apparatus belonging to said Town

of Lebanon or which may hereafter be owned by the Town of Lebanon is hereby turned over into the possession and control of said Engine Company No 1 or such other Companies as may hereafter be organized, subject to the provisions herein after provided in this Ordinance

Sec. 5. That it shall be the duty of said Engine Co No 1, to take good care of said Hand Engine and all fire Apparatus now or which may hereafter come into their possession and to keep the same in good working order

Sec. 6. It shall be the duty of the Firemen of said Company, to make a quarterly written report, beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> 1885, to the Town Council, of the condition of all property held by said Company and to present any and all claims for repairs or otherwise, for the safe keeping and good condition of said Fire Apparatus

Sec. 7. That the Town Council, reserves the right in case said Engine Co No 1 fails to keep up the number of active Firemen as provided for in Sec. 2 or take good care and keep in working order the Hand Engine and other Apparatus as mentioned in Sec. 4 of this Ordinance, to take immediate possession of all of said Property and to otherwise dispose of the same

as the interests of the Town require

Sec. 8. That any person who shall take or remove any Hooks Ladders, Buckets Hoses, Engine, Haze Cart or any part of said property or any other property belonging to the Fire Department of the Town of Lebanon and which is now or may be hereafter placed in possession of Lebanon Engine Co No 1 or any other Company duly organized under the direction or approval of the Town Council, from the place where such property is kept by said Engine Co No 1 or such other company, except upon the written order of the foreman of said Company or Companies, shall on conviction before the Records be fined not less than five Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars or by imprisonment not less than five days nor more than Twenty five days or fine and imprisonment both.

Sec. 9. That this Ordinance to be in full force from and after five days publication by posting
