

Ordinance no 26

Relating to the amendment of section seven of ordinance no one concerning the Town elections and Town organization.

The People of the Town of Lebanon do ordain as follows

Sec one That section seven of ordinance no one concerning the Town Elections and Town organizations be amended so as to read as follows, whenever any councilman or ~~other~~ officer chosen or elected as provided in section six of ordinance no one shall fail to qualify or die, resign or remove from the Town or shall fail to attend two regular meetings of the council in succession without satisfactory excuse made to the council in person or in writing his office shall become vacant or declared so and the council shall proceed to fill the vacancy by appointment of some qualified resident of the Town

Sec 2 This ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after five days after its publication by posting

Ordinance No 27

Relating to establishment of Road district, appointment of Road & Street Supervisor, his duties, The assessment, Levy & collection of Poll & property tax for Street & Road purposes within Town limits & the repeal of ordinance No 14 fourteen & ordinance No 20 twenty relating thereto

The People of the Town of Lebanon
Do Ordain as follows

sec 1 That the corporate limits of the Town of Lebanon shall be and is hereby constituted a separate Road District

sec 2 That the Town council shall appoint a suitable person at the first regular meeting in
