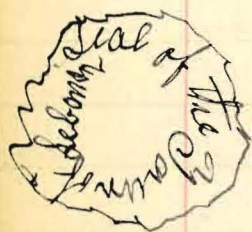

Ordinance No 27

Relating to establishment of Road district, appointment of Road & Street Supervisor, his duties, The assessment, Levy & collection of Poll & property tax for Street & Road purposes within Town limits & the repeal of ordinance No 14 fourteen & ordinance No 20 twenty relating thereto

The People of the Town of Lebanon
Do Ordain as follows

sec 1 That the corporate limits of the Town of Lebanon shall be and is hereby constituted a separate Road District

sec 2 That the Town council shall appoint a suitable person at the first regular meeting in

March of each year as road & street supervisor who shall hold his office for the period of one year whose duty it shall be to collect all taxes for Road & street purposes within the corporate limits of the Town of Lebanon and expend the same thereon under the direction of the Town council, who may be removed at any regular meeting of the Town council for violation of Duty

sec 3 The Town Recorder shall cause within three days there after a certified copy or notice of such appointment, as road & street supervisor to be delivered to the person so appointed which notice or order shall be evidence of the authority of such person to act as such & that said supervisor shall also file with the Recorder an oath subscribed by him that he will faithfully & honestly discharge the duties of street & road supervisor as required by this ordinance

sec 4 That each male resident of the Town of Lebanon between the ages of twenty one and fifty years except active fireman of any company for one year prior to the assessing of Road Taxes shall be required to pay the sum of two Dollars as Poll Tax each year to the street & road supervisor the same to be applied on the streets & roads within the corporate limits of said Town

sec 5 In addition to section four (4) of this ordinance there shall be a Levy of two Dollars for each one thousand Dollars

as a street and road tax, upon the assessable property within the Town limits the same to be expended on the roads & streets within said Town limits

see 6 It shall be the duty of the road & street Supervisor on or before the 20th day of March of each year to obtain the names and make out in alphabetical order a complete list of all persons subject to Poll & property tax for street & road purposes residing within the corporate limits and file the same with the recorder and it shall be the duty of the recorder within ten days thereafter to ascertain by assessment the amount of Poll and property tax for street and road purposes the same being entered in a book denominated the assessment book and affix to each name the amount of such Poll and property tax as provided in section four (4) and five (5) of this ordinance, of all persons residing in or who have property within the Town limits

see 7 The assessment of real and personal property for street and road purposes by the recorder shall be unless otherwise provided in this ordinance the same as provided in ordinance No three (3) relating to the duties of town recorder and as provided in ordinance No five (5) relating to the assessment, levy and collection of town taxes

Sec 8 It shall be the duty of the Town council at the first regular meeting in April of each year following the assessment made by the recorder to carefully examine said assessment as entered in said assessment book and to correct all errors and irregularities in said assessment and to hear all or any complaints by any tax payer either in person or by agent or attorney and to adjust the same and otherwise change and alter said assessment so that all persons and property may bear their just proportion of tax for road and street purposes

Sec 9 when the town council has passed upon said assessment as provided in the preceding section it shall be the duty of the recorder to make out a complete list of the names of all persons on said assessment book with the amount which each is liable for poll or property tax or both as the case may be and deliver said list with the amount under his hand and town seal to the road and street supervisor authorizing and commanding said road and street supervisor to collect the amount set opposite such name for road and street purposes within the corporate limits of said town, provided further that should the name of any party subject to poll or property tax be omitted from said list it shall be the duty of said supervisor to insert the names of all so omitted with the amount of property and poll tax against each as provided in this ordinance, and collect the same which shall be as legal as though said assessment was done in due time

sec 10 On receipt of said list by the road and street Supervisor as provided in section nine (9) of this ordinance it shall be his duty to proceed in due time to collect from each party the amount found on said list giving to said party a receipt for the amount so paid should any person fail or refuse to pay to the road and street supervisor the amount of poll and property tax for street and road purposes as provided in this ordinance within three days after demand of the same by the supervisor said person shall incur double the amount of said poll or property tax to be added thereto the same to be recovered by action & against said party by the supervisor in the recorder's court in the name of the Town of Lebanon and the judgment if rendered in favour of the town shall be for the amount of tax penalty and costs of said action which judgment may be enforced the same as a judgment by fine in a criminal action

sec 11 It shall be the duty of the road & street Supervisor within ten days after collecting said poll & property tax for road & street purposes as provided in this ordinance to turn over all moneys received by him to the town Treasurer taking the Treasurer's receipt therefor which money shall be kept by the town Treasurer as a separate fund to be denominated the road & street fund to be expended upon the roads & streets within the corporate limits of said town

sec 12 The road & street supervisor with the consent of the comitty on streets & roads of the town council of the Town of Lebanon may upon such terms & conditions as may seem best for the publick interest enter into a contract upon ten days notice previously given with the lowest responsible bidder for working & grading and otherwise improving the roads & streets within the corporate limits of said Town provided that no contract shall be entered into with a non resident of the Town when as good terms are proposed by a responsible resident, and provided further that in case said road and street work is contracted for as in this section provided, said contractor shall give preference to all labourers & teams within the town limits who may apply for work on the roads & streets, any violation by any contractor of the provisions of this section shall work a forfeiture of any contract so entered into & be held null and void

sec 13 It shall be the duty of the road & street supervisor in case no contract is entered into as provided in section Twelve (12) of this ordinance to employ men and teams for the purpose of working the roads and streets within the corporate limits of said Town giving preference in all cases to residents of said Town, any party so employed or who may furnish any material at the request of the road & street supervisor shall furnish to the supervisor a statement of the time employed the material furnished and the price of the same, which statement if found correct shall be endorsed by the supervisor as correct, & said supervisor shall draw a warrant on the road & street funds in the hands of the ^{Town} Treasurer for the payment of the same

sec 14 If any road & street supervisor shall neglect to perform the duties required of him by this ordinance or who shall under any pretense what ever give or sign any receipt for road & street tax unless the money shall have been paid or pay out money to any person for labor or material ^{where no labor or material have been furnished} or shall fail or refuse to pay over all moneys received by him, to the Town treasurer as required by this ordinance shall be fined not less than five Dollars nor more than fifty Dollars for each & every offence, complaint may be made by any tax payer before the recorder for violation of this ordinance by the road and street supervisor

sec 15 Said street & road supervisor shall receive for collecting the poll & property tax for road and street purposes five percent of all sums so collected & paid over to the Town treasurer, & in addition thereto: Shall receive for each day necessarily employed in superintending the working of the roads & streets & in discharge of any other duty required of him by this ordinance, the sum of Two Dollars & fifty cents per day, said supervisor shall at the first regular meeting in August & January of each year make out a full & complete report of the amount of money collected for road & street purposes and turnover to the ~~Town~~ ^{Town} treasurer the amount paid out, to whom paid & for what purpose together with a true statement of the amount due him for the proper performance of his duties as by this ordinance directed & if said bill is found true and correct the Town council shall allow the

some and a warrant shall be ordered drawn on the road & street funds in the hands of the Town Treasurer for the same

Sec 16 That Ordinance No 14 relating to establishing of road district appointment of road supervisor his duties & the assessment Levy and collection of poll & property tax for street & road purposes and ordinance No twenty (20) relating to fireman are here by repealed

Sec 17 That this ordinance to be in full force & effect from & after five days after publication & posting ~~passed the~~
