

Ordinance No 29
 Relating to additional compensation
 of Town Marshal

On as much as the compensation now allowed the marshal is utterly inadequate for a faithful performance of the duties required of the marshal, Therefore the people of the town of Lebanon do ordain as follows

- sec one That the Town marshal shall be allowed the sum of five Dollars per month as an additional compensation for the services required of him in the discharge of his official duties
- sec two That any Town marshal refusing or neglecting or failing to discharge his official duties as required shall forfeit all of the additional compensation as provided in section one of this ordinance
- sec three It shall be the duty of the Town Recorder at the close of each month to draw a warrant for the sum of five Dollars on the Town Treasurer in favour of the Town marshal as provided in section one of this ordinance which shall be paid when duly signed by the president the same as any other warrant by the Town Treasurer from the Town fund
- sec 4 This ordinance to be in full force & effect from & after five days after its publication by posting, Passed the council July 19 - 87
